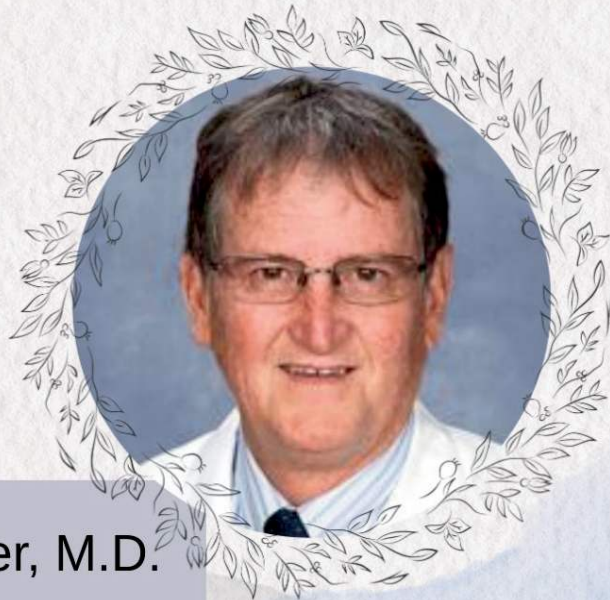

Featured Saint of the Week

St. Lucy Filippini **Feast Day: 3/25**
(11/13/1672-3/25/1732)



Born in the Papal States and the youngest of five, Lucy was orphaned by the age of six. She was sent to live with an aristocratic aunt and uncle who encouraged a life of faith that included her schooling with the Benedictine nuns in Santa Lucia.

Once she completed her schooling, Cardinal Barbarino spoke with her about establishing a Catholic institute for educating poor young girls, becoming a nun, and leading a community of sisters. He felt her talents supported her service to God in these various capacities.

Lucy and Cardinal Barbarino first co-founded the Religious Teachers Filippini, a group dedicated to the education of girls. Rose Venerini joined Lucy in teaching both domestic arts, and Christian doctrine.

The Cardinal put together a set of rules to guide Lucy and her followers in the life of a religious community. The Religious Filippini was credited with both religious and social improvement of Italian women long before education was required.

Pope Clement XI recognized her work, and called upon her in 1707 to continue her work in Rome.

She was known as a "pioneering educator and devoted nun" that established schools for young girls and trained teachers, while living a life of dedication to God and the mission of their institute. During her lifetime Lucy was able to establish a total of 52 schools.

Lucy unfortunately contracted breast cancer, which ultimately took her life in 1732 at the age of 60.

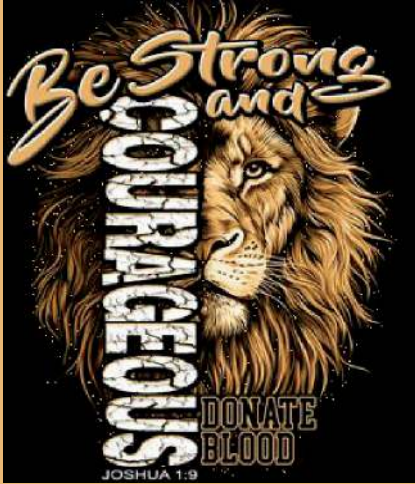
