

## **Featured Saint of the Week**

## St. John of Kanty (1390-1473) Feast Day: December 23

John Cantius was born in Kety, Poland. He was a very smart and well-educated man. His intellectual contributions spanned the fields of theology, philosophy, physics, and Holy Scripture. By age 28, John was teaching



philosophy classes at the university, while preparing for the priesthood. He was quite popular with the students, because he cared and helped them not only in their studies, but spiritually, mentally, physically and financially. Once ordained, he continued teaching and ministering to the students. His work thrived.

During this time there were debates to support a growing movement to have the pope submit to the authority of Church councils (conciliarism). John was a staunch defender of the papacy. Some of his rivals submitted false charges against him on the issue. He was not even allowed to appear and testify in his own defense and was subsequently convicted, unjustly.

John was dismissed from the university in 1431, and was reassigned as an apprentice pastor to a church in Bohemia. This particular church was known as a "dumping ground for disgraced priests" and his assignment there was not welcomed. Despite being unfairly fired, John embraced this new venture. He totally poured himself into ministering to the people, and won them over. After serving for 8 years John was finally exonerated; his congregation did not want him to leave. He returned to Krakow, Poland where his position was reinstated.

During his lifetime he made a number of pilgrimages to various places, including Rome which he did 4 times; the round trip to Rome was 1800 miles. He died in Poland at the age of 83.


## **Martha's Meals of Mercy**
