

## Fr. Jason's Wishful Thinking: Our New Sanctuary Furnishings

Dear Friends in Christ.

On Friday, January 24th, Bishop Duca will join us for school Mass at 8:30 AM to bless our new altar, tabernacle, ambo, cantor's stand, and credence table. This is a beautiful ritual that most Catholics rarely get to see in their lives, so I wanted to invite you to it. We will also record it and have it available for viewing as we have the Sunday Masses each week. We would normally have such a liturgy on a Sunday, but Bishop Duca's schedule is quite full in January and February due to confirmations, Catholic Schools Week festivities, and Masses and events at St. Joseph Cathedral.

In preparation for the installation of the new furnishings, Firmin Construction will be moving equipment into the church on Sunday, January 19<sup>th</sup> after all of the Masses are completed. We will be moving the current altar--and one of the concrete podiums--to the far end of the pavilion at the Parish Activity Center. We will also move the baptismal font to a different location inside of the church. Minor repairs to the floor will be needed.

Daily Masses will take place in the St. Francis Room on January 21-23 as we work in the main church. The new altar and the four additional pieces are made from 200-year-old carved wood altarpieces from a closed church in Belgium. These two altarpieces had to be carefully taken apart, sanded down, and re-fashioned into what we needed for St. Alphonsus Church. Ronnie Deaton, Glen Jarreau, and Larry Buhler did this work as volunteers, and I commissioned Mrs. Tina Guillory of Denham Springs to do all of the painting and gold accents that you will see on them soon.

The main altar has paintings of the twelve apostles, minus St. Matthew, St. John, and Judas. St. Paul (the apostle to the Gentiles) is in place of Judas Iscariot. St. Matthias and St. Barnabas are in place of St. Matthew and St. John since they were gospel writers and are featured on the ambo (reader's stand). The ambo has paintings of the four gospel writers (along with their symbols from the Book of Revelation), and other evangelists from the first century including Mary Magdalene, Aquila & Priscilla, Timothy and Titus. The cantor's stand features male and female saints who composed sacred music or played instruments during their lifetimes. The altar of the Blessed Sacrament has four angels on the front, holding the instruments of Jesus' crucifixion. Along the two sides, there are twelve female saints who had great devotion to Jesus in the Eucharist. I hope that you will enjoy learning about these particular saints, as you see these paintings, to be reminded that the saints and angels are present with us during the celebration of Mass.

#### **Featured Saint of the Week**

## St. Hermann Joseph (1150-1241) Feast Day: April 7

Born in Cologne, Germany, his given name was Hermann von Sternfeld. By the young age of seven, Hermann was known for his devotion to the Blessed Virgin. He spent as much time as possible in church, where he knelt in rapt prayer to Mary.



By the time he was 12, he entered the abbey of Premonstratensian Canons Regular (more commonly known as the Norbertines). He was still a bit too young to be accepted into the Order, so he was sent away for more studies. Upon his return he made his vows and was given the habit and the additional name of Joseph. Being a novice, he was initially assigned for service of the refectory (dining room); later he was assigned to the sacristy.

Fr. Hermann was known as a monk and mystic. It was remarkable with what reverence and devotion he offered the Holy Sacrifice. Sometimes he was sent out to perform pastoral duties, but he was also called upon for his skill in making and repairing clocks. Much of his outside pastoral care was as chaplain for several women's monasteries in the region.

His last assignment was as a chaplain, supporting the spiritual welfare of the Cistercian nuns. He died in 1241, at the age of 91.

Throughout his life he was characterized by his child-like devotion to Mary. He was known for his gentle demeanor, affability, and his humility. But above all he was known for his affection for the Mother of God, before whose altar he remained for hours in prayer and experiencing ecstatic visions. After his death a number of miraculous events were reported; healings of people suffering blindness, paralysis, possession, as well as many daily complaints such as headaches, toothaches, etc. were credited his intervention.

In 1626, Archbishop Ferdinand of Cologne and Emperor Ferdinand II requested that the canonization process for Fr. Hermann Joseph begin. For some reason however, the process was interrupted. He was still a "recognized saint" in his local area, but in 1958 Pope Pius XII confirmed his status within the worldwide church as a saint.

Personal Hygiene: Full Size shampoo and conditioner.


**Small Appliances**: Laundry baskets, laundry detergent and individual kitchen knives (no block sets).
