Featured Saint of the Week

St. Dulce Lopes Pontes (5/26/1914-3/13/1992)

Feast Day: 8/13



Sr. Dulce was born in 1914 as Maria Rita in Brazil, into an upper middle-class family. At the age of 13, her aunt took her to one of the poor areas of the city. She would never be the same. Having seen the “other side of life,” she began to care for the poor and sick in her own neighborhood.

She joined the Missionary Sisters of the Immaculate Conception of the Mother of God, at 18. At this time she took the religious name of Dulce to honor her mother. Her goal was to provide shelter to the numerous poor and sick people she encountered in the streets. She initially housed them in abandoned buildings, bringing them food and medical care. Unfortunately, both she and her 70 patients were evicted with no place to go, so she asked her Mother Superior for help. She was given the convent’s chicken yard to convert into an improvised hotel. As part of the agreement, Dulce was asked to care for the chickens, which she did by butchering them to feed her patients! This site evolved to become the Santo Antonio Hospital, which continues to serve Brazil’s poor and sick/disabled.

Sr. Dulce continued her charitable works which included founding the Sao Francisco’s Workers Union that became the Worker’s Center of Bahia and the Charitable Works Foundation of Sr. Dulce, which is one of the most well-known and well-respected charitable organizations in Brazil.

In 1988, Brazilian President Jose Sarney nominated Sr. Dulce for the Nobel Peace Prize. Although she didn’t win, the publicity helped expose/expand her causes. It is of note that each of her efforts to help the poor and sick are still thriving.

Sr. Dulce battled respiratory problems for over 30 years, and succumbed to the illness in 1992 at the age of 77.
