Featured Saint of the Week

St. Artemides Zatti (10/12/80-03/15/1951)

Feast Day: 3/15



Artemides was born into a poor family in Italy, with eight siblings. He dropped out of school at the age of eight in order to help the family's finances by going to work. He found work, but his parents recognized that their fortunes were too low in the economic climate, and decided to relocate to Argentina in 1897.

In Argentina, Artemides met Fr. Carlos Cavalli, who encouraged him to become a member of the Salasians of Don Bosco. He began his novitiate with them in 1900 as a secular member. His solemn profession as a secular member took place in 1911.

While tending to tuberculosis patient, Fr. Ernesto Guiliani, Zatti contracted the disease. Zatti was sent to Viedma to recover. He credited his complete recovery to the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary. He shared that if she were to heal him, he vowed to commit his life to taking care of the sick.

By 1903 he was working in the hospital handling pharmaceuticals. He attended Mass frequently, and learned Spanish to better communicate in his adopted home. He continued to tend to the sick, whether they were in the hospital or elsewhere. His playful side tried to help patients relax; he was known to participate in a bocci game or two, to entertain them. He then visited hospital patients, and ended his day by reading spiritual texts. His days spanned from 4:30AM until about 11:00PM. Amazingly it was during this time that he also earned a nursing diploma.

In July 1950, Zatti fell off a ladder as he climbed to the roof to fix a water tank. He was able to fully recover from the fall; shortly after healing, he diagnosed himself with liver cancer. He was hospitalized from January until March of 1951 when he died at the age of 70.


