### Featured Saint of the Week

#### St. Rafaela Mary of the Sacred Heart of Jesus (3/1/1850-1/6/1925) Feast Day: 1/6



Rafaela was born in 1850 into a large family in Spain. She had one sister and eleven brothers; her father was the mayor of Cordoba. He died in 1854 while tending to cholera victims during the epidemic.

Her mother nurtured Rafaela's relationship with Jesus, helping her to develop a deep devotion to Christ.

In 1874, Rafaela and her sister Maria Delores went to the local Poor Clare convent to discern their respective vocations. The two sisters joined the religious congregation, the Sisters of Mary Reparatrix. It was at this time that Rafaela chose her religious name of Rafaela Mary of the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

When the congregation decided to move to Seville, the pair along with some others chose to remain. With the help of the local bishop, they founded the Institute of Adorers of the Blessed Sacrament as well as the Daughters of Mary Immaculate. This was the origin of the congregation that Rafaela and her sister would establish.

Maria and the group received their final vows in 1877. The group of 18 then moved to Andujar, and then to Madrid where the congregation received diocesan approval from the Archbishop. The papal decree of praise from Pope Leo XIII was issued in 1886. At this time the congregation was officiated as the Handmaids of the Sacred Heart of Jesus; the final papal approval was given in 1887. Rafaela was appointed as Superior. Under her leadership, the congregation grew.

After a misunderstanding with her colleagues, she felt it beneficial to resign. In her place she appointed her sister.

She went to live in their convent located in Rome. She died in her room in 1925 of natural causes, at the age of 74.

Decades after her burial, her body was found to be preserved and flexible.


