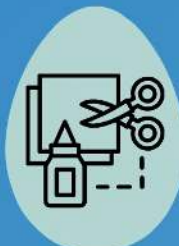

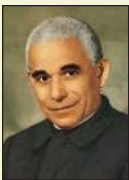

Featured Saint of the Week

St. Luigi Orione (6/23/1872 – 3/12/1940)

Feast Day: 5/16



Luigi was born into a poor family in the Piedmont region of Italy. At 13, he entered a Franciscan Friary, but due to his poor health, he left after just one year. Subsequently, he became a student of the Valdocco Oratory operated by the Salesians of Don Bosco. Fr. Bosco took note of Orione, who was one of his favorite pupils. After attending Fr. Bosco's funeral, he was miraculously cured!

Orione wanted to become a priest, so he entered the seminary in Turin. The impact of his education from Don Bosco's school motivated the 20-year-old seminarian to open his own oratory to educate the poor boys of the city.

His ordination took place on April 13, 1895. Shortly after, he founded a religious congregation called the Sons of the Divine Providence. The local bishop provided full authorization and support. In 1908, Orione traveled to two areas of Sicily that had been decimated by earthquakes. In 1915, another earthquake devastated Marsica. Again, he offered help, and founded the Little Missionaries Sisters of Charity. Orione's penchant for helping the poor expanded at the end of WWI. He founded schools, farming colonies, charity organizations, and nursing homes, making sure to focus on the orphans and the poor.

Orione began to suffer serious cardiac and pulmonary problems in the winter of 1940. He was forced to take leave to recuperate. He said: "It is not among the palm trees that I would like to die, but amongst the poor who are Jesus Christ." He died on March 12, 1940 at age 67. He was buried in the church he'd built himself in 1931, honoring the Madonna for ending the hostilities of WWI. He was canonized on May 16, 2004.

Even today, the charitable organizations he founded are still operating in abundance throughout the world.

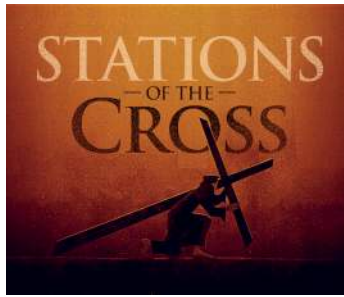
