Fr. Jason's Wishful Thinking: Parish Census & Shroud of Turin Exhibit

Dear Parishioners in Christ,


Each year, all church parishes submit a “Spiritual and Pastoral Report” to the Diocese, which includes statistical data about baptisms, weddings, funerals, etc. This information is compiled by the bishop’s office and sent to the Vatican. This information is used at the diocesan level to see where growth is happening, and perhaps to gauge where evangelization or reform is needed. At the end of 2023, St. Alphonsus Liguori Parish had 2,725 registered families. At the end of 2025, we had 2,985 registered families, and by the end of January 2026, we surpassed 3,000 families. As I write this bulletin article at the end of February, we now number 3,015 families! This is an 11% increase in two years. The City of Central is indeed growing.

Just a reminder that if your cell phone number, address, or email has changed, please let our office staff know, so that we can keep you connected.

Along with the increased number of families, we have seen noticeable growth in our school enrollment. Currently, St. Alphonsus School has 464 students. When Ms. Monsour and I arrived (at the end of the 2023-2024 school year), enrollment stood at 438 students. We are pleased to announce that enrollment for the upcoming 2026-2027 school year will be close to 485-490 students, which includes our new special education section. Meanwhile, all of our teachers and support staff will be returning for the next school year, which speaks volumes about the environment and strength of our parochial school. Meanwhile, we have begun the initial stages of long-term, strategic planning as we think about future building needs.

As we find ourselves in the middle of Lent, I think it is good that we reflect on the Lord’s Passion in meaningful and tangible ways. Lisa Lively, Dale Hodges, Chip Lovett, and I are working on a semi-permanent exhibit concerning the Shroud of Turin (the burial cloth of Jesus Christ). After many years of doing Shroud presentations in various church parishes, I feel it is now time to house the artifacts and my framed copies of the Shroud in a place where they might be accessible. We will utilize the small foyer at the southwest corner of the church, which exits to the Gather Space), to house the Shroud of Turin display. We hope that you will enjoy learning about one of the most important relics that we possess in Christendom.

Featured Saint of the Week

St. Geneveva Torres Morales
(1/3/1870 – 1/5/1956)
Feast Day: 1/5



Geneveva was born in Almenara, Spain; she was the youngest of six children and the only girl. During the yellow fever plague at that time her entire family, except her older brother died from the illness. In spite of her hard life, her faith never waived. Her brother, Jose respected her but he was taciturn and he didn't show much affection. She was fully expected to work with him to make a better life.

Growing up with limited affection, she became comfortable with solitude. In 1882, she had a knee infection that required an amputation; thereafter walking with crutches for the rest of her life. She was sustained by her spiritual reading.

In 1885, she moved to a hospice run by the Carmelites. She stayed there for almost a decade, during which time her spiritual life greatly deepened. Although, she wanted to join the congregation, her health prevented it.

She returned home with the idea of establishing a congregation with a special focus on caring for lonely, poor, and elderly women. She consulted Fr. Martin Sanchez, a Jesuit priest, who helped her in the planning stages of her mission.

The first house opened in Valincia in 1911, following soon with two additional houses. Since the General House was established, she added a novitiate program which led to the founding of her own congregation. It was called: Congregation of the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Holy Angels. The sisters came to be known as the "Angelicas".

Geneveva's health began to decline, as deafness was added to her list of ailments. Papal approval for the congregation by Pope Pius XII was received in 1953. In 1954, she resigned her post as Mother General.

She died in January of 1956 at the age of 86. Due to her peaceful and humorous disposition with a deep faith in Jesus, her nickname was "Angel of Solitude."

Fall 2026 Parish Pilgrimage to Italy

Fr. Jason will be leading a pilgrimage to Italy from October 28-November 11, 2026. This pilgrimage will be limited to 40 parishioners and includes five stops in Sicily (Palermo, Catania, Syracuse, Taormina & Messina), then crossing over the Strait of Messina to visit the temples of Paestum, stopping in Salerno to visit the tomb of St. Matthew, spending time in Sorrento along the beautiful Mediterranean coast, visiting the archaeological site at Pompeii, wine tasting and pizza in Naples, stopping at St. Alphonsus's burial place in Pagani, spending three days in Rome (seeing the major basilicas), and ending with a visit to Assisi to follow in the footsteps of Saints Francis, Clare, Ruffino, and Carlo Acutis.

Total cost of the 15-day trip will be approximately \$5,650 per person (double occupancy) based on current exchange rates. This includes airfare, travel insurance, and all tips for the guides, food servers, bus drivers, and the tour manager.
