Featured Saint of the Week

St. Jozef Sebastian Pelczar

(1/17/1842- 3/28/1924)

Feast Day: 1/19

Jozef Pelczar was born in Poland. He said that from a very early age he felt a strong calling to serve God. He journaled: "Earthly ideals are fading away. I see the ideal of life in sacrifice, and the ideal sacrifice in priesthood".



After completion of his studies, he was ordained a priest on 7/17/1864. His first assignment was as a parish priest; he later transferred to Rome where he continued his studies, receiving doctorates in both theological studies and canon law. He then returned to Poland, serving as a college professor until 1883.

Pelczar moved forward establishing libraries, delivering free lectures, and publishing quite a number of books. He also established a school for those who were servants. He then organized the Fraternity of Our Lady Queen of the Polish Crown in 1881 to care for the poor, orphans, the sick, and for those without jobs.

In 1893 with the help of Sr. Ludwika Szczesna, the two established the Sister Servants of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, to help women in need.

In 1901, Pope Leo appointed Pelczar as Bishop of Przemyśl. The new Bishop was passionate about a number of issues: work reform, better seminary education, with access to more resources, and wanting to be a hands-on bishop. He made frequent visits to all parishes within his diocese, and supported all religious orders. He held episcopal meetings to discuss one of his top priorities: the implementation of Pope Leo XIII's encyclical Rerum Novarum. This delved deeply into the conditions of the working class, mutual duties between labor and capital, as well as between the government and citizens.

Pelczar died on March 28, 1924, with a strong reputation for holiness, and was hailed as a shepherd who paid close attention to pastoral issues. His successor eulogized Pelczar by saying: "The late Bishop of Przemyśl personified the most beautiful qualities and talents of the episcopate".

Fall 2026 Parish Pilgrimage to Italy

Fr. Jason will be leading a pilgrimage to Italy from October 28-November 11, 2026. This pilgrimage will be limited to 40 parishioners and includes five stops in Sicily (Palermo, Catania, Syracuse, Taormina & Messina), then crossing over the Strait of Messina to visit the temples of Paestum, stopping in Salerno to visit the tomb of St. Matthew, spending time in Sorrento along the beautiful Mediterranean coast, visiting the archaeological site at Pompeii, wine tasting and pizza in Naples, stopping at St. Alphonsus's burial place in Pagani, spending three days in Rome (seeing the major basilicas), and ending with a visit to Assisi to follow in the footsteps of Saints Francis, Clare, Ruffino, and Carlo Acutis.

Total cost of the 15-day trip will be approximately \$5,650 per person (double occupancy) based on current exchange rates. This includes airfare, travel insurance, and all tips for the guides, food servers, bus drivers, and the tour manager. Daily lunch and donations at the churches we visit are separate and at your discretion. If you are interested, please contact the Church Office at 225-261-4650.
