Featured Saint of the Week

St. Luigi Versiglia (6/5/1873 – 2/25/1930)

Feast Day: 2/25

Luigi was born on June 5, 1873 in Italy; as a child, he was an altar server. His parents sent him to school at one of the oratories managed by the Salasians of Don Bosco.



Unlike many priests, Luigi did not feel a calling to become a priest; his heart was set on becoming a veterinarian. His Salasian education extended from 1885-1889; after this, he made the decision to join the Salasian order. Don Bosco himself noticed Luigi's fervor, and asked Luigi to come see him soon, as he had something important to tell him. This was in 1887; but the meeting never took place, as Fr. Bosco fell ill and died in 1888.

Luigi received a doctorate in philosophical studies in Rome. He felt the time was right for him to pursue his priestly training, however he needed special dispensation to be ordained because he was under the canonical age requirement. His ordination actually occurred on 12/21/1895. He was appointed as novice master at Genzano in Rome, developing a reputation for his strict austerities and discipline.

Fr. Versiglia led the first expedition for Salasian missionaries into China in 1906. He wasted no time upon his arrival. He established a motherhouse for the order, while opening a new mission in the Shaoguan region; Pope Benedict XV appointed him its first apostolic vicar (bishop) in 1920. He went on to found an orphanage, several care homes for the aged, and 2 leper colonies. Fr. Versiglia loved tending to the needs of the people in various capacities, whether as a gardener or barber.

Fr. Versiglia along with fellow Salasian, Fr. Callisto Caravario, were travelling via boat along the river to the Lin-Chow mission. They were stopped by Bolshevik pirates who then boarded their vessel. The pirates planned on abducting and enslaving 3 girls on their boat, but the priests shielded them. The pirates knocked the priests unconscious, tied them up and rummaged through their things. They threw away any crucifixes they found.

The priests were dragged ashore into a thicket. Five rifle shots ended the priests' lives. Their bodies were recovered two days later. Fr. Versiglia was martyred at age 56.

FORMATION

PSR Registration

Public and private school student's K – 7 are required to register for PSR each year. If your child is in public or private school K-7 grade they will need to register for religion classes. Registration for the 2026-2027 year will begin June 1, 2026 look for registration forms on our website, in the back of the church and in the Faith Formation Office.

1st Reconciliation & Eucharist Registration

Parents of 2nd Grade or older are required to register for their children for the sacraments of 1st Reconciliation and 1st Eucharist. Your child must have had one year of religion or have attended one year of Catholic school. Registration for the 2026-2027 year will begin June 1, 2026.
