Featured Saint of the Week

St. Anne Line (1563 – 2/27/1601)

Feast Day: 2/27

Anne was born “Alice Higham,” the eldest in her Puritan family in Essex. Her father was William Higham, a Protestant reformer under King Henry VIII. It is believed that she was born circa early 1560s. At some time in the early 1580s she converted to the Roman Catholic Church, along with her brother William and Roger Line, the man she would marry in 1583. Both men were disinherited for converting; Alice lost her dowry then changed her name to Anne. As punishment for the alleged crime, Anne’s husband was banished and settled in Flanders, never to see his wife again.



When Fr. John Gerard received word of Line’s death, he opened a house of refuge for hiding priests, having the newly-widowed Anne Line in charge of it. Fr. Gerard was imprisoned, and despite her chronically impaired health, Anne continued to run the house. Fr. Gerard eventually escaped from prison in The Tower of London and returned to the refuge house.

Anne gave up managing the house, but Fr. Gerard knew that Anne was well-known enough that it would be unsafe to live anywhere near her. Instead, Anne rented some apartments in another building and continued to shelter priests there.

Anne had invited an unusually large number of Catholics for Mass of the Purification of Our Lady. Neighbors noticed the large crowd, and soon the constables were at the house. During the raid, Anne was arrested, although Fr. Francis Page was able to escape because of Anne’s previous planning.

For the trial, Anne was so weak from fever that she had to be carried in. Her response to the charges was that she did not regret having concealed a priest, but she only grieved that she could not receive a thousand more. The judge sentenced her to death for the felony of assisting a seminary priest. Anne was hanged on February 27, 1601, immediately before two priests scheduled for hanging and quartering.

She was canonized a martyr in 1970 by Pope Paul VI.

FORMATION

PSR Registration

Public and private school student's K – 7 are required to register for PSR each year. If your child is in public or private school K-7 grade they will need to register for religion classes. Registration for the 2026-2027 year will begin June 1, 2026 look for registration forms on our website, in the back of the church and in the Faith Formation Office.

1st Reconciliation & Eucharist Registration

Parents of 2nd Grade or older are required to register for their children for the sacraments of 1st Reconciliation and 1st Eucharist. Your child must have had one year of religion or have attended one year of Catholic school. Registration for the 2026-2027 year will begin June 1, 2026. Look for registration forms on our website and in the Faith Formation Office.

Confirmation Registration

All 8-11 grade students that have not received Confirmation are asked to register for sessions in preparation for this sacrament. Registration will begin June 1. Forms can be found on the parish website or in the Faith Formation Office.
