Featured Saint of the Week

**St. Alphonsa of the Immaculate Conception
(8/19/1910–7/28/1946)**

Feast Day: 7/28



Born in Kerala, India as Anna Muttathupadathu, was a nun and educator. Her early life was filled with challenges, one of which was losing her mother at a very early age. After her mother's passing she was raised by a maternal aunt who was rather strict. While living with her aunt, her grandmother made sure she was exposed to stories of saints, prayers, and Christian songs. When she reached adolescence, she received several marriage proposals from well-known families. Anna felt a strong calling to the religious life and desired to become a "bride of Christ," dedicating herself to saving others. Her conviction was strengthened by a vision of Therese of Lisieux, whom Anna considered a role model.

In 1923 her feet were severely burned when she placed her feet into a pit of burning chaff. The injury was self-inflicted to prevent her foster mother from arranging a marriage, and assuring her the freedom to pursue her religious calling. Because of the injury she was partially disabled for the rest of her life.

Anna joined the Franciscan Clarist Congregation a religious congregation of the Third Order of St. Francis, where she completed her education. This was a branch of the Poor Clares. In August of 1928, she received the postulant's veil and took the name Alphonsa of the Immaculate Conception in honor of St. Alphonsus Liguori, whose feast day was being celebrated. She became a nun of the Syro-Morabar Catholic Church, which is part of the Eastern Rite of Catholicism.

She immediately began teaching, but when her foster mother died, she resumed her studies. She then entered another novitiate program. After finishing her novitiate in 1931, she took her first vows and become a fully professed member of the Roman Catholic Church, wanting to work as a nun after Therese of Lisieux.

Two days after professing her religious vows, she returned to teaching; but her health was now dictating what she could and could not do. She dealt with severe illness throughout her time with the Clarist congregation. She suffered a bout of pneumonia, and then she developed gastroenteritis and liver issues.

Sr. Alphonsa continued to experience more health complications; she died on September 28, 1946 at the age of 35. She is the first saint from India.

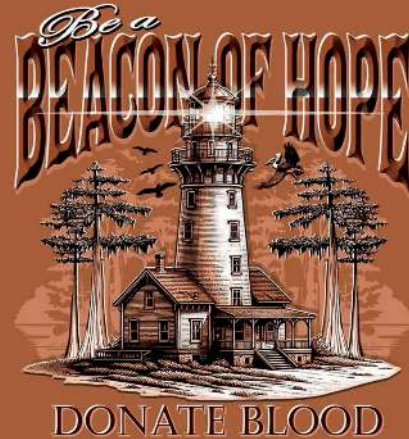

PSR Registration

Public and private school student's K – 7th are required to register for PSR each year. If your child is in public or private school K-7th grade they will need to register for religion classes.
