Featured Saint of the Week

Blessed Joseph Gerard (3/12/1831 – 5/29/1914)

Feast Day: 5/29



Joseph Gerard was born in France. He was the eldest of five children all of whom helped with the family farm. His education was with the Oblates of Mary Immaculate (OMI). The Oblates served as a missionary order. His education with the Oblates probably contributed to his strong desire to become a missionary priest.

After completing his basic schooling, he actually joined the order to begin his novitiate. He began his theological studies in France, but had to go to South Africa for missionary work, and completed his studies there, where he was ordained a priest. He made his perpetual vow on 2/19/1854. Joseph was quite adept at learning languages, which was rather helpful while doing missionary work in foreign countries. His first assignment was to work in the territories of Zulu and Natal; conversing with people in their own language however, in this case was not much help.

He then joined with the Bishop in starting the first Catholic mission in Lesotho. Right from the start, Joseph went to the king, requesting his permission to found the “Village of the Mother of Jesus” mission. Joseph was granted the authority, because the king was already impressed with Joseph since he continued to work in the country during the Free State-Basotho war. The king went so far as to approve the Christian authorities to consecrate Lesotho to the Blessed Virgin Mary in August 1865. Gerard was now truly enjoying his mission work.

His time was spent serving the three missions that he'd formed. He travelled either on his horse, or on foot but always accompanied by the Holy Eucharist. All of his work and travel eventually caught up with him. In April of 1914, Gerard became sick, with no immediate cause. His body was just plain worn out. He was bed-ridden for well over a month when he succumbed, dying on May 29, 1914 at the age of 83.

After his death each of the three missions organized and put together a service to honor the priest they had come to love.

FORMATION

PSR Registration

Public and private school student's K – 7th are required to register for PSR each year. If your child is in public or private school K-7th grade they will need to register for religion classes. Registration for the 2026-2027 year will begin June 1, 2026, look for registration forms on our website, in the back of the church and in the Faith Formation Office.

Confirmation Registration

All 8-11th grade students that have not received Confirmation are asked to register for sessions in preparation for this sacrament. Registration is open. Forms can be found on the parish website or in the Faith Formation Office.

1st Reconciliation & Eucharist Registration

Parents of 2nd Grade or older are required to register for their children for the sacraments of 1st Reconciliation and 1st Eucharist. Your child must have had one year of religion or have attended one year of Catholic school. Registration for the 2026-2027 year will begin June 1, 2026. Look for registration forms on our website and in the Faith Formation Office.

Want to learning about the Catholic faith?

Inquiry begins in August. Meetings are held on Thursday evenings August through November in the St. Clare Room at 6:30 pm. The classes will transition to OCIA sessions in December. 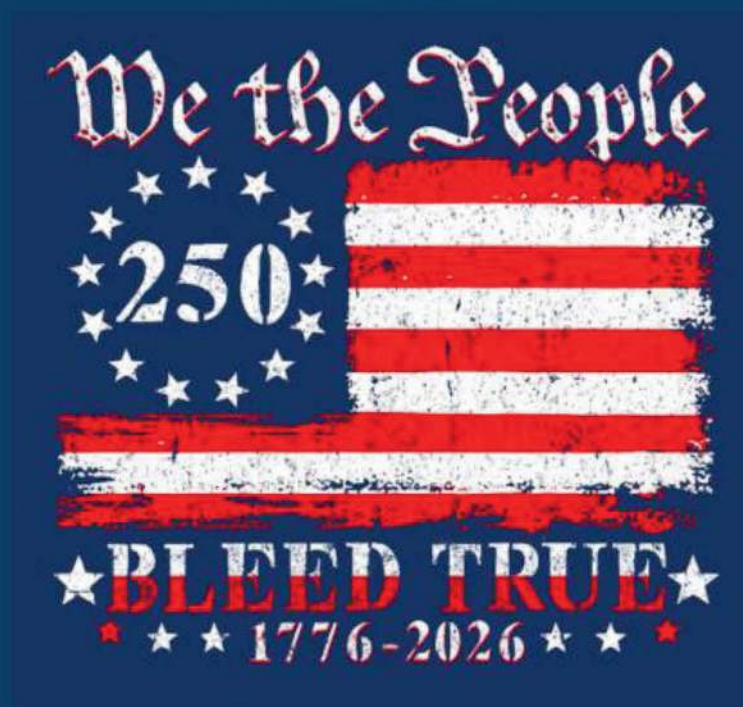
