Featured Saint of the Week

Blessed Marcel Callo (12/6/1921 – 3/19/1945)

Feast Day: 3/19



Marcel Callo was born on 12/6/1921; he was the 2nd of 9 children. His mother made sure that all of her children grew up knowing and loving God, and their Catholic faith. The entire family saw God as a central part of their lives. Marcel loved to catechize every chance he could.

WWII was ongoing; Germany had seized the territory. It was after a German bombardment that flattened the City, when he found his sister's body under the rubble.

As WWII progressed, he received his notice for Service of Obligatory Work to serve in Germany. Failure to report would result in the arrest of the man's family. Before he left, Marcel told his aunt, "Yes, I will do everything possible to do well because you know that it is not as a worker that I leave, but as a missionary."

He reported to the factory as instructed, where they made rockets that would be used against the French people. While living in the barracks with others, they were told that they were not prisoners, and could come and go as they pleased.

Marcel became totally elated once he was able to arrange for a French Mass. All of the people were very pleased, and requested a monthly Mass. Unfortunately, his religious activities were brought to the attention of the German officials which prompted his arrest. As he was led away someone in the crowd demanded a reason for the arrest. The Gestapo responded that "he was too Catholic."

During interrogation Marcel admitted engaging in Catholic activities and that he knew it was forbidden in Germany. He was in jail in Gotha then he was moved to the prison at Mathausen. He deteriorated to the point where he suffered from general weakness, fever, swelling, bronchitis, malnutrition, and dysentery. He died on March 19, 1945, the feast of St. Joseph.

Pope JPII beatified him on October 4, 1987.

FORMATION

PSR Registration

Public and private school student's K – 7th are required to register for PSR each year. If your child is in public or private school K-7th grade they will need to register for religion classes. Registration for the 2026-2027 year will begin June 1, 2026, look for registration forms on our website, in the back of the church and in the Faith Formation Office.

Confirmation Registration

All 8-11th grade students that have not received Confirmation are asked to register for sessions in preparation for this sacrament. Registration is open. Forms can be found on the parish website or in the Faith Formation Office.

1st Reconciliation & Eucharist Registration

Parents of 2nd Grade or older are required to register for their children for the sacraments of 1st Reconciliation and 1st Eucharist. Your child must have had one year of religion or have attended one year of Catholic school. Registration for the 2026-2027 year will begin June 1, 2026. Look for registration forms on our website and in the Faith Formation Office.
