Featured Saint of the Week St. Filippo Smaldone (7/27/1848-6/4/1923)

Feast: June 4

Filippo was born in Naples, Italy. As a youth, he experienced social, political, and

religious turmoil; he chose instead to dedicate his life in service of the church.

During his priest training, he saw a need and became involved in helping marginalized people, including the deaf and mute. He wanted to help these people because there was no other form of appropriate assistance for them.

He was ordained a priest on September 23, 1871.

A cholera epidemic in 1884 affected hundreds of people. Filippo himself was struck down, but the intervention of Our Lady of Pompei awarded him what he considered a miraculous cure.

Filippo was not getting the level of progress he expected from his students and therefore asked to be transferred to work with foreign missions. Thankfully his superiors convinced him to stay.

Throwing himself into his work, he joined forces with a couple of co-workers who ultimately founded a school for the deaf and mute in Lecce, Italy. The institution became the mother house for the newly formed Congregation of the Salesian Sisters of the Sacred Hearts of Jesus and Mary. The school soon made tremendous progress expanding their work to include the blind, orphaned, and abandoned children. With such success, the school was able to branch out with several locations in other cities in Italy.

Filippo also founded the Eucharistic League of Priest Adorers, and the Eucharistic League of Women Adorers to promote the Eucharist. He was appointed and served as a canon of the Lecce Cathedral. He was also awarded a commendation by civic authorities for his work.

On June 4, 1923, Filippo died from diabetic-related complications combined with heart problems. He was 74.

Martha's Meals of Mercy will bring meals to parishioners that are just coming home from the hospital, have just had a new baby, or are going through a traumatic time. The meals will be delivered for a short time- 2-3 times a week for 2-3 weeks.

If you or someone you know could benefit from this ministry OR if you would like to be a Martha and provide meals, please notify the parish office at 225-261-4650. A representative of the ministry will call back and get information such as the number of people in the family, food allergies, likes and dislikes.

Those receiving the meals will be asked to place a cooler at their door where the food will be placed at a specific day and time. That way they will not be disturbed.


