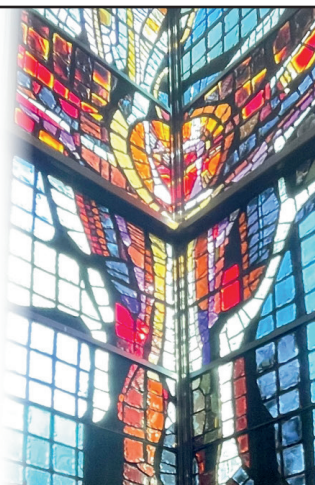

Featured Saint of the Week

St. Anna Schaffer

2/18/1882-10/5/1925

Feast: 10/5

Anna's father died at the age of 40. His death put a tremendous financial strain on the family. Anna quit school, to help the family financially. Anna's own life plan was to eventually join a religious order; but due to her family situation, her plans had to be put on the back burner.

In 1898 Anna had a vision of Christ, who told her that she was destined to endure long and painful suffering.

In 1901, while working at a laundry, Anna slipped and fell, basically boiling her legs in the washing machine. At the hospital, little could be done about the painful burns. She underwent more than 30 operations; her pain persisted. The skin grafts did not succeed, and Anna became completely bed-ridden and immobile.

Anna was eventually sent home; she never lost her optimism though, despite her constant pain and suffering. To help herself, she became even more devoted to her faith.

On the many nights when she couldn't sleep, she continued to express her adoration of Christ and her veneration of Mary. She also felt a special devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. She received the Eucharist daily.

In 1910 a mystical phenomenon developed around her, what could be described as a stigmata, which she tried to conceal from the public.

In 1925, Anna was diagnosed with colon cancer; her paralysis spread to her spine, making it difficult to speak or write.

On October 5, 1925 she received her final Eucharist, and suddenly spoke: "Jesus, I live for you!" before she died. She was 43 years old.

Clergy Dinner

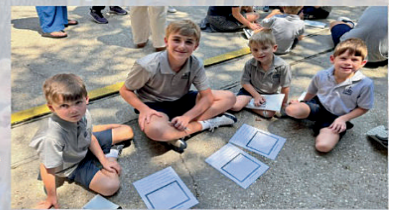
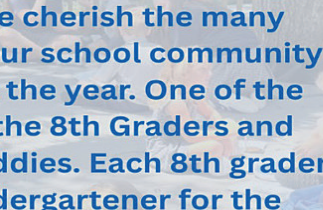
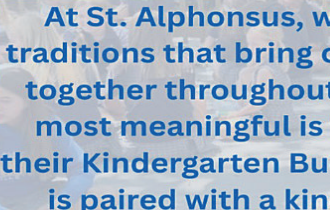
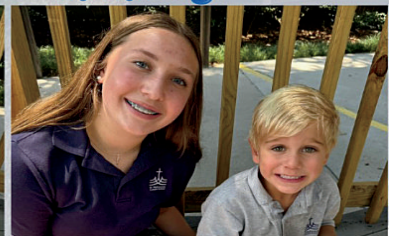
