Featured Saint of the Week

**St. Pauline of the Agonizing Heart of Jesus
(12/16/1865-7/9/1942)**

Feast: July 9



She was born in Vigolo Vitaro, in Austria-Hungary, as Amabile Lucia Vesintainer. She and her German Catholic family emigrated to Brazil.

Even as a youth, she was known for her piety and charity; she spoke of giving her life to God. Her great love for the Catholic faith imbued within her a focus on the suffering and the poor. Her First Communion provided the gateway for her active participation within her local parish. She taught catechism to children, visited the sick, and cleaned the local chapel.

It was in 1890 that Amabile and her friend, Virginia Nicolodi, with the spiritual direction of Jesuit priest, Fr. Luigi Rossi, committed their lives to religious service under dedication to the Immaculate Conception of Our Lady. A terminal cancer patient donated her small house to the community. By 1895, there was apparently a need for a more formal and secure organization for the newcomers.

They decided to establish a religious congregation called the Little Sisters of the Immaculate Conception, which was approved by the Bishop of Curitiba. In December of 1895, Amabile and her friend both took their religious vows. Amabile took the name of Pauline of the Agonizing Heart of Jesus.

With continued growth, Sr. Pauline moved to Sao Paulo to open a second branch of the order to take care of orphans, the children of former slaves, as well as the aged slaves who'd been left to die because they could no longer work.

Pope Pius XI granted a Decree of Praise to the Congregation of the Little Sisters on May 19, 1933, which established them as having pontifical right.

Pauline's health began a slow decline due to diabetic complications. The last months of her life, she was totally blind and had an arm amputated. She died on July 9, 1942; her last words were, "God's will be done."
