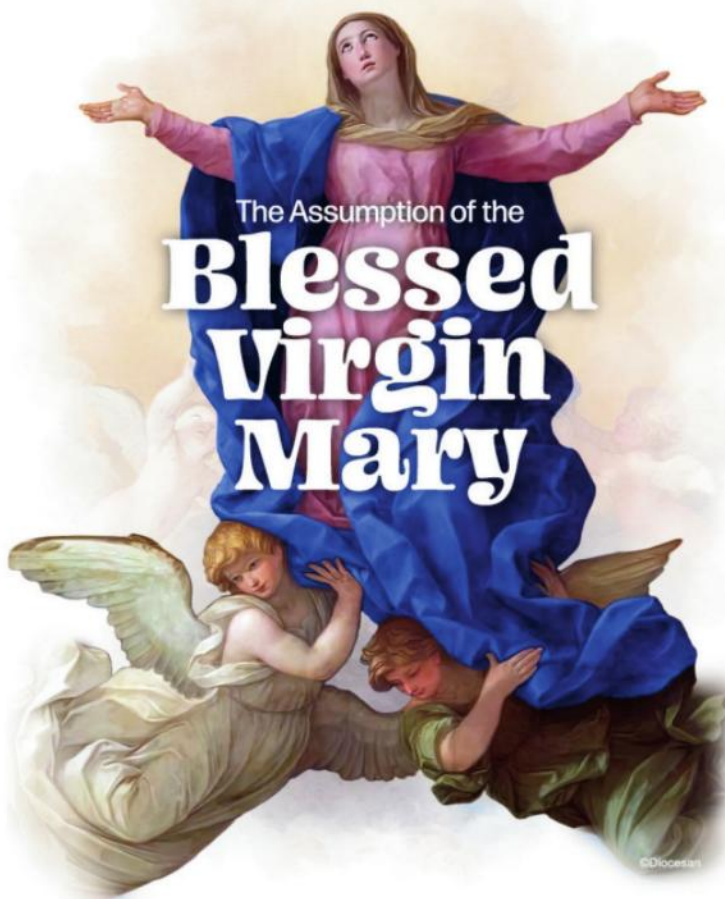

Featured Saint of the Week

St. Giuseppe Moscati
(1880-1927)

Feast: November 16

Giuseppe was born into a family of nobility, the seventh of nine children. His father was a well-known lawyer and judge; his mother was of noble birth. The family regularly practiced their faith.



The multi-talented Moscati was an Italian lay doctor and scientific researcher in the 19th and 20th centuries. He had a variety of interests for career paths, but it was his brother's untimely accident when he sustained serious head trauma that cemented Giuseppe's interest in pursuit of a medical career.

Giuseppe started his university study of medicine in 1897. He graduated at the top of his class, receiving his doctorate in medicine in 1903.

Mt. Vesuvius erupted in 1906 just a couple of miles from the hospital where Moscati was working; he treated plenty of geriatric and paralytic patients during this time.

With the cholera breakout in Italy in 1911, the government cast Moscati to lead public health inspections. Additionally he was to research both origins of the disease as well as the best way to eradicate it. Ultimately, most of his ideas were put into practice.

Moscati went on to receive a doctorate in physiological chemistry. After this degree, he was the first to introduce insulin therapy in Italy and was considered a pioneer of diabetology and endocrinology.

Throughout his career many times he did not charge for his services and routinely bought food for the poor. He never forgot to look at the entire person to evaluate their true needs.

The above article is just the tip of the iceberg of this brilliant man's knowledge culminating in innumerable works, some of which continue impacting medicine and people even today. He died of natural causes on April 12, 1927.
