### Featured Saint of the Week

**St. Carlo Acutis: The Millennial Saint**  
**Canonized 9/7/2025**  
**Feast Day 10/12**



Carlo Acutis was an extraordinary young man. He seemingly entered into this world on a pre-determined mission from God. He was certainly a typical teenager, was interested in sports, music, and computer games. He loved the computer so much, he figured out how to develop web pages to transport information around the world. Carlo's deepest interest though, was his faith and the sharing of it, which helped him to stand out from his peers. But this was not always a good thing.

His pastor asked him to teach Catechism class. At the end of the first class, he realized that his peers had no understanding as to the importance of the Mass, but what really surprised him is that they had no clue that each Mass has a miracle happen. He felt his peers were missing out on getting to know Jesus.

Carlo decided to start a project to make sure that Eucharistic Miracles could be seen by anyone interested, throughout the world. This project actually took over 2 years to complete. He compiled and succinctly presents the scientifically verified information on 187 Eucharistic Miracles. ([www.miracolieucaristici.org](http://www.miracolieucaristici.org)).

However, Carlo was not one dimensional. He also felt the need to help the poor, homeless, and any animals in need. Wherever his family traveled, he would visit every church possible to sit for Eucharistic Adoration.

Carlo was born on May 3, 1991; diagnosed with acute leukemia on October 8, 2006. He went unconscious on October 11, 2006, and succumbed to the disease on October 12, 2006. Carlo Acutis fit so much life in his 15 years, but knowing his life was so special, he wanted everyone to experience his same level of joy.

The Vatican has not yet given specific times for the ceremony, but many if not all of the Catholic media outlets will do their part to get it broadcasted.



**Love, Joy, Peace, Patience, Kindness, Goodness, Faithfulness, Gentleness, and Self-Control.**


