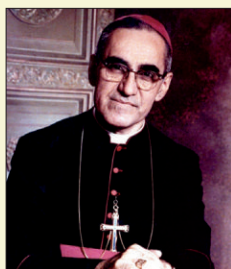
Featured Saint of the Week

St. Oscar Romero

8/15/1917-3/24/1980

Feast Day 3/24

Oscar Romero voluntarily entered seminary at the age of 13. His final vows to become a priest had to be delayed because he wasn't old enough. Once ordained, and began his ministry, he was seen as a social conservative. Politics were brewing, resulting in the outbreak of the Salvadorian Civil War. All Catholics, clerics and religious were in danger of being arrested, tortured, and/or being put to death. Throughout the war, no less than 100 priests alone were killed.



Oscar's dear friend, Fr. Rutilio Grande was murdered. This impacted Oscar's entire life! So moved by this tragedy, Oscar became an outspoken social activist against poverty, and social injustice in his country.

On the day before his assassination, Oscar used his radio broadcast to speak out against violence and the escalating conflict. He said:

"No soldier is obliged to obey an order that goes against the law of God. I beseech you. I beg you. I command you! In the name of God: 'Cease the repression!'"

The very next day, while Bishop Romero was celebrating Mass in a small hospital chapel, he saw a gunman appear at a rear door. He knew what was coming. The gunman fired a shot striking Romero in the heart. He dropped in front of the crucifix.

Even as Romero's funeral was taking place, the war was unrelenting. Smoke bombs were being thrown into the crowds where they exploded, indiscriminate rifle shots were killing mourners. Romero's body was ultimately buried in a crypt beneath the sanctuary.
