



STEWARDSHIP OF FINANCE REPORT REPORTING PERIOD JULY 1, 2024 – JUNE 30, 2025

The role of the Finance Council is to advise the pastor on matters relating to the financial management of the parish. We review and approve the annual church budget and review monthly revenue and expenses. Each year your Finance Council is charged with the responsibility to report the financial condition of the parish to our parishioners. 

Featured Saint of the Week

St. Jozef Bilczewski 4/26/1860--3/20/1923 Feast: 3/20

From an early age, the Polish born Jozef Bilczewski had a deep interest in using his life to serve God. His youth and early adulthood were focused on his education, and making the best use of his talents. Once he received his two doctorate



degrees, he served as a theological and dogmatic professor at Lviv College.

He had a well-deserved reputation as a learned and cultured man. So much so, that Emperor Franz Joseph I nominated him to become the head of the archdiocese in Liviv. Pope Leo XIII agreed, and at the age of 40, Jozef was named as the new archbishop.

As Archbishop, Bilczewski had a broad range of initiatives, mostly for revitalizing the faith within the people, and also moving forward in developing ecumenical cooperation with other denominations.

There was a host of other things the Archbishop foresaw: helping the poor, plus with the onslaught of WWI, organizing food and relief for those displaced and/or refugees. He stayed mostly behind the scenes trying to smooth tension in several areas of unrest. He initiated construction of many new churches in the archdiocese, encouraged devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, as well as urged priests to implement Eucharistic Adoration in their parishes. He organized courses for priests, enabling them to become more involved in social work for the poor. He financed several Catholic societies, and was quite popular with many students of all creeds. He also instituted the first Mariological Congress in Poland.

On March 20, 1923 he died due to an autoimmune disease, pernicious anemia. As requested, he was laid to rest in the cemetery of Janow, known as the cemetery of the poor. He was 62.


