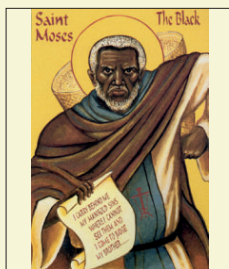

Featured Saint of the Week

St. Moses the Ethiopian

330 AD - 405 AD

Feast Day 8/28



Moses was a slave working for a government official, until he was dismissed for theft and suspected murder. His physical stature was huge, he also had strength and courage; the perfect physical traits to lead a gang of robbers. There were about 75 in the group he led, and they became a social menace and caused terror to the communities where they roamed. His last "job" was thwarted by a barking dog. Since he couldn't get into the house, he decided to steal 4 sheep, selling their fleece for wine.

Knowing that the authorities were after him, he sought refuge in a colony of monks in the desert. Moses was affected deeply by the monks' dedication to their lives and the peace and contentment they experienced.

Moses gave up his old way of life, became a baptized Christian, and joined the monastic community. Moses of course, had challenges with some of the regular monastic discipline. He, himself was attacked by some robbers while in his desert cell. He overpowered the robbers, and dragged them to the chapel where the other monks were in prayer. He told his fellow monks what happened, and that he didn't think it was Christian to hurt the robbers, so he asked what he should do with them. Surprisingly, the robbers themselves repented, and joined the community as brothers.

When a brother had committed a fault, Moses was invited to discuss the appropriate penance. At first he declined the offer, but being asked a second time, he decided to attend. He arrived carrying a large sack filled with sand. When asked why he was carrying it, he replied: "My sins run out behind me and I do not see them, but today I am coming to judge the errors of another". Upon hearing this, the monk that was charged was forgiven.

In the year 405 AD word came about a group of robbers planning to attack the seminary. The monks wanted to defend themselves. Moses reminded them, "All who take the sword will perish by the sword". Moses himself opted to stay behind unarmed; he was joined by seven others, all unarmed. The bandits did attack, martyring all eight monks. Moses was about 75 when he died.

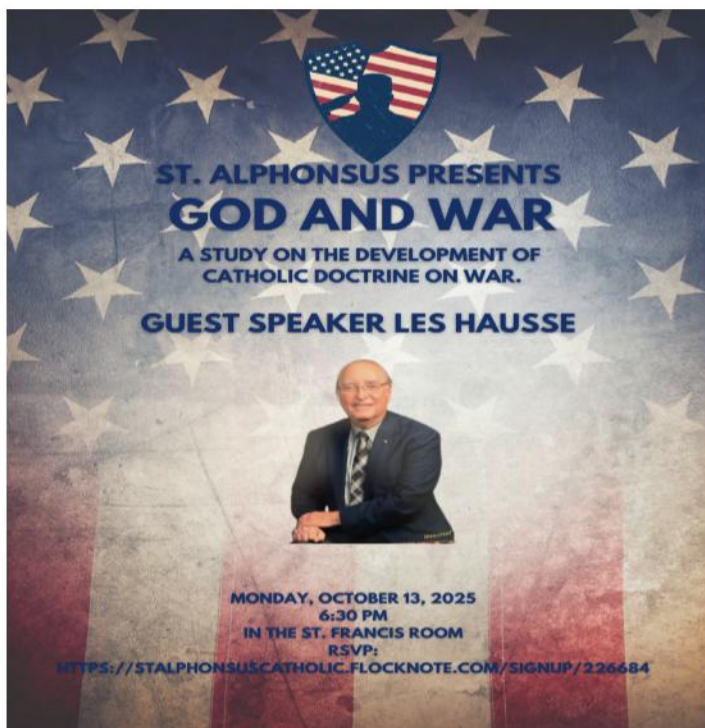
