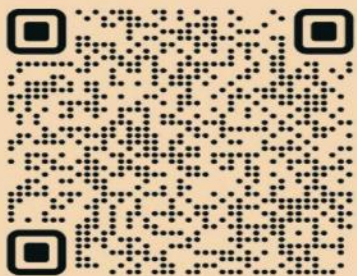

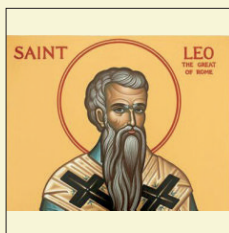

Featured Saint of the Week

Pope St. Leo the Great
Circa 400-11/10/461
Feast Day 11/10



Born into a family of Roman aristocrats; he responded to the call of the Lord, and became an exceptional Pope. Leo first became a renowned deacon of the church under the pontificate of Pope Celestine I. He was widely respected for his love of the Lord, his intelligence, and his persuasive nature. He used that persuasiveness to bring reconciliation between disputing Christians, whether theological or secular.

Leo was out of town when his predecessor, Pope Sixtus died in 440 AD. However, despite his absence, he was unanimously elected Pope. (At this time the Pope was elected by popular vote of the people and clerics. Cardinal conclaves started in 1271.)

His initial plan as Pope was to oppose and root out heresies. He was a staunch defender of the faith. He wanted to share the importance of Jesus' role as both human and divine, as well as the fullness of the incarnation including its implications for all who are baptized in Jesus Christ.

He actually led Rome's defense against Attila the Hun, by taking on the role of peacemaker. The result was that Attila retreated, leaving Italy without overtaking any of its cities.

Pope Leo I, was known for his profoundly spiritual sermons. He was seen as an instrument of the call to holiness. He was well-versed in Scripture and "ecclesiastical awareness", which helped him to become one of the greatest popes in the history of the Church. He died on November 10, 461. Pope Benedict XIV named him as a doctor of the Church.

Pope Leo I, felt quite privileged to sit in the Chair of Peter as servant of servants to God. He was fully cognizant of both the importance and impact the position carried. Pope St. Leo the Great unequivocally held to the belief that everything he did and said as Pope, represented Jesus Christ and our first Pope, St. Peter.
