



Featured Saint of the Week

St. Jaime Hilario Barbal 1/2/1898-1/18/1937 Feast Day 1/18

He was born Manuel Barbal i Cosan in northern Spain. His formal schooling began in 1911 when he attended a religious school for seminarian preparation, but was forced to withdraw due to some hearing problems. In 1917 he entered the novitiate program at the Institute for the Brothers



of the Christian Schools. It was here that he was given the religious name of Jaime Hilario, and the habit of the order. He soon began to thrive; regarded as an exceptional teacher and catechist. He also taught Latin, and was a believer in universal education, with emphasis on the poor. With his hearing deteriorating, he was forced to step down from teaching and began working as a gardener.

The Spanish Civil War broke out in 1936. One of the first decrees was to outlaw the practicing of the Catholic faith, and to arrest, torture, and jail all clerics. Jaime was arrested for being a member of a religious congregation. The following year, Jaime was convicted of being a member of the De La Salle Brothers and punished by execution. The initial rounds failed to harm him, so he was shot at close range 5 times. Once it's determined that someone was killed "in hatred of the faith", they are eligible for beatification. Barbal was beatified on 4/29/90. For canonization, a miracle is still required. A validated miracle was approved, and Jaime Barbal was canonized a saint 11/21/1999 by Pope St. John Paul, II.


