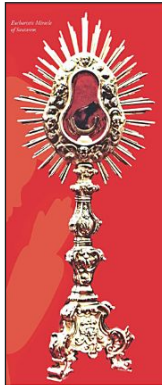
As of Tuesday, November 1, 2022, we have received a total of **\$222,042 dollars in pledges.**

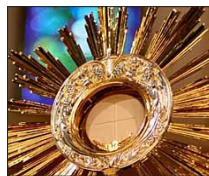

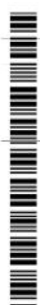
