# Featured Saint of the Week St. Colette of Corbie (1579-1601) Feast Day: March 6

It was only after many years of prayer that Colette, an only child, was born to her parents. Colette's biography says that her mother was 60 years old when she was born. Unfortunately, by the time Colette was 18, she'd lost both of her parents. Colette did receive a small inheritance, but she chose to distribute those funds to the poor.



She'd tried joining a couple of Monasteries, but nothing felt right to her. She eventually became a Franciscan tertiary, and lived in solitude becoming known for her holiness and spiritual wisdom.

Around 1406, Colette began having dreams, indicating that she was to reform the Poor Clares. She felt that this calling was to bring the Order back to its original ideals specifically, absolute poverty and austerities.

She approached Benedict XIII, the antipope in Avignon, France, for permission to move forward with her work. Benedict XIII approved her plan, plus she was appointed as the Superior of each convent she opened. The first reformed convent she opened was in 1410; she continued her work ultimately opening 17 additional convents. She was also instrumental in helping to reform some of the older convents as well. The reformed order was known as the Colettine Poor Clares, clarifying the difference in the Order's rule.

Colette was also known for miracles attributed to her. They ranged from multiplication of food and wine, curing various illnesses/medical conditions, and the ultimate miracle, bringing someone back to life. These miracles were witnessed while she was alive, and some came after her death.

Colette died in 1447, at the age of 66; she was living in Ghent, Belgium.

The Colettine Poor Clares are still thriving today with monasteries world-wide.

# Silver Rose Ceremony Thursday, November 14 at 12 PM Mass

In 1531, Mexican peasant Juan Diego received a message from a mysterious woman twice. The second time, she told Juan Diego to go to the top of a nearby hill and pick the roses there. He placed them in his tilma and returned to the lady, who arranged the roses and instructed him to ask the bishop to build a



church there. In the presence of the bishop, Juan Diego opened his tilma. The roses fell to the floor, revealing the image of Our Lady of Guadalupe on his tilma. The bishop ordered the construction of a church to begin immediately.

In 1960, the Knights of Columbus began transferring a rose from the U.S. to Mexico for the feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe. The program began with a natural rose to commemorate the miracle of the roses. Since then, the rose has been changed from natural to wood, bronze, and finally, silver. Each year from early March through mid-December, silver roses are stewarded by Knights of Columbus councils along routes from Canada to Mexico. Every stop the silver rose makes is a rosary-centered occasion for Knights, parishioners, and community members to pray for respect for life and for the spiritual renewal of each nation.






# 2025 St. Alphonsus Auction and Taste Fair
