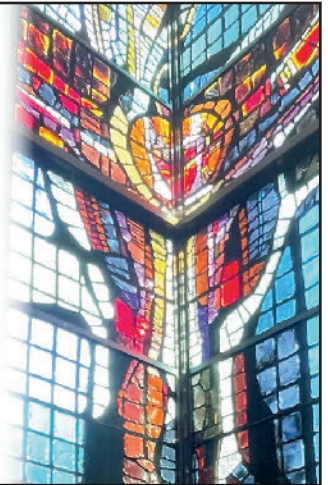

Fr. Jason's Wishful Thinking

As the month of November draws to a close, I wanted to take a moment (in the spirit of Thanksgiving) to publicly express my gratitude to all of you! November was a fabulous month all around! It was highlighted by three weddings, nine baptisms, a successful Fall Fest, an edifying Veterans Day celebration, the completion of our church painting project, a record-breaking Hornet Run at the school (with donations still coming in), the completion of our statue project with the installation of St. Juan Diego, FULL attendance at Fr. Miles' T.O.T. presentation, and a wonderful church staff enrichment day in St. Francisville. And let's just say that other grace-filled moments happen every day around here. What a month!

Now, I want to step back to July when I presented the annual financial report and we faced a budget shortfall for the upcoming year, and I gently encouraged everyone to consider their stewardship to the parish. My message was if we collectively made small increases, then it would add up and the shortfall would take care of itself. You answered that call, and thus far, we are slightly above the budget with income as we get close to the mid-point of the year. **THANK YOU** for your continued generosity to our church parish! It gave me the confidence to move forward with our landscaping improvements that are coming soon. I hope that once it is completed, you will agree with me that our church and grounds will look quite refreshed, and these investments will serve us well for several years into the future.

As Advent is upon us, we think ahead to the Giving Tree and some of the social justice concerns "in our backyard." Jesus tells us "the poor will always be with you." This year, Catholic Charities has completely revamped its Christmas wish list, moving away from toys and electronics as so many families are approaching them for financial assistance. Keeping the utilities on in a home is much more of a necessity than the latest gadget. Please consider Catholic Charities' request to help desperate families this year by participating in our Giving Tree. We also have other options available that will provide needed socks and other essentials to local prisoners, and there are other options for giving as well. Please keep the staff of Catholic Charities in your prayers as they have faced incredible budgetary shortfalls this year and operate with a smaller staff, due to federal funding cuts.

Finally, the weekend of December 5-6 is upon us. I am pleased to showcase my Christmas village display in the St. Alphonsus rectory for the first time. This hobby started in 1990 when my great aunt, Sedonia Louviere, began making plastic canvas needlepoint houses for me, and over time, the collection has grown to over 800 pieces in three distinct displays: New York, London, and Walt Disney World. I will host an open house on December 5-6 in conjunction with the St. Alphonsus Craft Show & Festival. We have approximately 40 craft vendors signed up. The Catholic Daughters will be selling food both days. The youth group will have a unique competition for the adults and children. There will be FREE children's activities on Saturday afternoon. Our vision is to grow this event next year by adding other activities, such as an antique car show and possibly a cook-off.

As we look ahead to Advent, don't forget about the key virtue of the season: **patience**. Try to be more patient when you wait in line or when you are stuck in traffic. God often reminds me that I need to SLOW DOWN in these moments, and He wants to teach you that as well.


