Featured Saint of the Week

St. Nicholas (3/15/270-12/6/343)

Feast Day: 12/6

The *original* St. Nicholas was born just 270 years after Jesus. Unfortunately, although St. Nicholas died at the age of 73, there is not much documented information about his life.

We do know that he was of Greek origin, born in Asia Minor which was part of the Roman Empire at the time. He was an only child, whose parents were considered wealthy. His parents did not live to see him grow-up, as they died during an epidemic when he was relatively young.

Nicholas grew up in the Eastern Orthodox tradition, first becoming a priest and then appointed a Bishop. Nicholas was very caring and kind noticing the highs and lows in peoples' lives. He wanted to help wherever and however he could. He ultimately used everything he had, including his inheritance to make lives easier.

Others took notice, and began doing the same thing; miraculously, his generosity spread throughout the world!

St. Nicholas' kindness did travel throughout the world, but due to various languages and traditions St. Nicholas is known by several different names. We call him Santa Claus, in the Netherlands he's known as Sinterklaas, Papa Noel is what he's called in Spain and Latin America, in France, he's known as Pe're Noel. Here in America we also call him Kris Kringle, Jolly Old Saint Nick, and Father Christmas.

Whatever name he is called, we all know that his name is connected to good things! One of his greatest wishes is that each of us, follow his example to be nice and look for ways that we too can pass on the special gift of giving to others.

Neither niceness nor gifts have to involve money. But can you think of any better way to spend the rest of Advent by being nice and doing things for others? I'll bet Santa has more than enough room for all of our names on his nice list!
