

Featured Saint of the Week

Pope St. Pius X (6/2/1835-8/20/1914)

Feast Day: 8/21



Pope Pius X was born Giuseppe Melchiorre Sarto, and was 2nd of 10 children. His father was the village postman. Although they were poor, his parents valued and emphasized education. By the age of 10, Pius was taking his school classes and was also learning Latin from the local priest.

Once he was ordained as a priest, he excelled at each assigned position. He was not assigned to a specific parish, but was given positions that held a bit more authority and input into the workings of the diocese. He moved through the ranks from his original ordination in 1858; then in 1879 he was ordained a Bishop. He became a Cardinal in 1893; and was elected Pope to lead the Catholic Church in 1903.

The governance of the Church by Pope Pius X was guided by his motto, "To restore all things in Christ." He was known for vigorously opposing modernist interpretations of Catholic Doctrine and for promoting liturgical reforms and the theology of St. Thomas Aquinas (Thomist beliefs), which was to be taught in school.

He initiated the preparation of the 1917 Code of Canon Law, but because of his death it was his successor, Pope Benedict XV that actually promulgated it.

He was devoted to the Blessed Virgin Mary, under the title of Our Lady of Confidence. For advancement of the liturgy, he promoted active participation of the faithful and he also promoted frequent reception of Holy Communion. He was praised for lowering the age to receive First Communion. He took on a reform of the Roman Curia. Pope Pius X had a firm demeanor and a sense of personal poverty, rejecting any kind of favors for his family and close relatives.

Even before his death he was credited with responsibility for a number of miracles. After his death there were several miracles validated by the Vatican, assuring him a place in heaven. He died of a heart attack on 8/20/1914 at the age of 79.






2026 St. Alphonsus Auction and Taste Fair
