Featured Saint of the Week

St. Catherine Laboure'

5/2/1806-12/31/1876

Feast: 11/28



Catherine Laboure' was born the 9th of 11 children whose parents farmed for a living. Her mother died when Catherine was 9, and she turned to the Virgin Mary to be her spiritual mother. She and her sister were sent to live with an aunt for a time, and Catherine was soon blessed with visions. One of the first was seeing a young priest, later recognized as Fr. Vincent de Paul. He told her it was good to care for the sick. He went on to say that God had a plan for her.

Catherine began her novitiate in 1830; soon after she was awakened, hearing the voice of a child calling her to the chapel. At the chapel, the Virgin Mary said to her: "God wishes to charge you with a mission. You will be contradicted, but do not fear; you will have the grace to do what is necessary. Tell your spiritual director all that passes within you. Times are evil in France and in the world." Mary returned to her later during evening meditations. She displayed herself inside an oval frame, standing on a globe; rays of light came out of her hands in the direction of the globe. Around the margin of the frame appeared the words, "O Mary, conceived without sin, pray for us who have the recourse to thee." The frame also showed a circle of 12 stars surmounted on a cross by the stylized Sacred Heart of Jesus and Immaculate Heart of Mary underneath.

Mary then told Catherine to bring the images to her father confessor, telling him that they should be put on a medallion. "All who wear them will receive great graces." It was 2 years before the priest presented the idea to the archbishop without revealing Catherine's identity. The request was approved and went into production. The Miraculous Medal was exceedingly popular and quickly adopted by millions of faith-filled Catholics.

Immediately after taking her vows, she was sent to the Hospice d'Enghien. She spent the next 40 years caring for the elderly and infirm. She was called the patroness of seniors and was known for her devotion to the poor and elderly, her humility, and profound silence. She died in the Hospice in 1876 at the age of 70. It was only on her deathbed that Catherine revealed her involvement with the Miraculous Medal. When she was first being considered for beatification, her body was found to be incorrupt.
