Featured Saint of the Week

**Blessed Franz Jagerstatter
(Martyr)**

5/20/1907-8/9/1943

Feast: 5/21



As a young boy, Franz was known as an avid reader, and a very good student, leaving school after his 14th birthday, as allowed by law.

When the German troops moved into Austria in 1938, Jagerstatter declined an offer to become mayor. Although he was the only villager to vote against the Nazi takeover, his vote of dissent was suppressed. He voiced his anti-Nazi opinion, saying "I believe there could scarcely be a sadder hour for the true Christian faith in our country. He had no political affiliations, but was openly anti-Nazi.

On the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception, he joined Third Order of St. Francis. The parish priest offered him work as a sacristan, therefore being deferred from military service, for a while.

When he was drafted in June 1940, he completed his training at the garrison. He refused to take the Hitler oath; however, he was able to return home in 1941 under an exemption as a farmer.

Because of his conscientious objection, he sought counsel from the local Bishop FlieBer, who told him "... he could only walk that path if he was sure that he was being called to do so by an extraordinary summons from above, not just from within himself..." The Bishop also reminded him of his degree of responsibility to his family.

Jagerstatter was next called to duty in February 1943; when he reported for duty, he declared his conscientious objection to the war. He offered to carry out non-violent services, but was ignored. He was immediately arrested, questioned, then imprisoned.

He was sentenced to death "and loss of military dignity and civil rights". Jagerstatter was executed by guillotine on 8/9/1943. His remains were cremated; the cremains salvaged.

Jagerstatter's family was denied any military benefits; they were finally approved in 1950. The death sentence was nullified by the Landgericht Berlin on 5/7/1997. Originally denied military burial, his remains were finally marked with a plaque at the burial at Sankt Radegund Cemetery in 2006.
