Featured Saint of the Week

Blessed Janos "Anastasius" Brenner
(12/27/1931 – 12/15/1957) **Feast Day: 12/15**

Janos Brenner was the second of three boys in his family in Hungary, and all three of them became priests. Janos attended Cistercian run schools; after his graduation he began his novitiate with the Cistercians, in 1950. At this time he took the religious name "Anastasius", which is Greek for "the resurrected".



His monastic studies had to be put on hold when the communist regime began suppressing all religious houses in Hungary; the novice master wanted to protect the men in the formation program, so he moved them from the abbey, placing them with families in private apartments.

The novices were still able to meet clandestinely for formation and fellowship. Anastasius chose to continue his studies in Budapest and Győr; he was ordained to the priesthood on 6/19/1955.

His first assignment was to be a chaplain at St. Gotthard, a parish that for centuries was under the care of the Cistercians along with an on-site monastery at one time. When he learned about communists' threats against priests, his bishop offered to transfer him. Brenner refused the offer, saying "I'm not afraid" and affirmed his desire to stay where he was.

On a December night in 1957 while working on his homily, he was summoned to give last rites to a supposedly ill man in the neighboring town. He failed to realize that it was a trap; the 17y/o messenger had actually been an alter server, he knew. Fr. Brenner brought the anointing oils and the Eucharist in his bag. He was ambushed in the woods, and stabbed 32 times. The next morning he was found dead, earning him the title: "Hungarian Tarcisius" since that martyr of the third century had been killed under similar circumstances.

The authorities failed when they attempted to disperse the crowds at his funeral.

He was then interred into the family vault in the Salesian church of St. Quirinus.

PSR Registration

Public and private school student's K – 7 are required to register for PSR each year. If your child is in public or private school K-7 grade they will need to register for religion classes. Registration for the 2026-2027 year will begin June 1, 2026 look for registration forms on our website, in the back of the church and in the Faith Formation Office.

1st Reconciliation & Eucharist Registration

Parents of 2nd Grade or older are required to register for their children for the sacraments of 1st Reconciliation and 1st Eucharist. Your child must have had one year of religion or have attended one year of Catholic school. Registration for the 2026-2027 year will begin June 1, 2026. Fall 2026 Parish Pilgrimage to Italy

Fr. Jason will be leading a pilgrimage to Italy from October 28-November 11, 2026. This pilgrimage will be limited to 40 parishioners and includes five stops in Sicily (Palermo, Catania, Syracuse, Taormina & Messina), then crossing over the Strait of Messina to visit the temples of Paestum, stopping in Salerno to visit the tomb of St. Matthew, spending time in Sorrento along the beautiful Mediterranean coast, visiting the archaeological site at Pompeii, wine tasting and pizza in Naples, stopping at St. Alphonsus's burial place in Pagani, spending three days in Rome (seeing the major basilicas), and ending with a visit to Assisi to follow in the footsteps of Saints Francis, Clare, Ruffino, and Carlo Acutis.

Total cost of the 15-day trip will be approximately \$5,650 per person (double occupancy) based on current exchange rates. This includes airfare, travel insurance, and all tips for the guides, food servers, bus drivers, and the tour manager. Daily lunch and donations at the churches we visit are separate and at your discretion.
