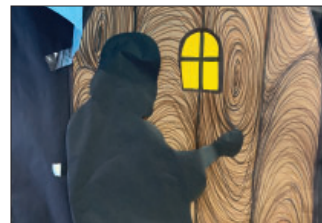
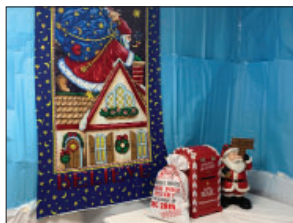
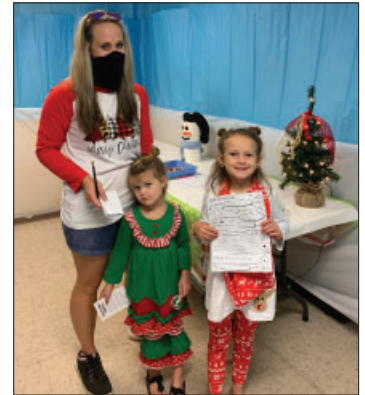
Mary Bible Study
