Fasting & Abstinence during Lent

In the Diocese of Baton Rouge, all Catholics are bound by the laws of fasting and abstinence during Lent.

Catholics aged 18 through 59 are obligated to follow the law of **fasting** on both Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Fasting means eating only one full meatless meal a day. Taking two other small meals that together do not equal a full meal is permitted. Food and drink “between meals” (except water) is not permitted.

Catholics aged 14 and up are required to **abstain from meat** on Ash Wednesday, all Fridays of Lent, and Good Friday. Abstinence means to abstain from eating meat. Eggs, milk, products, or condiments made from animal fat are allowed.

DISTRIBUTION OF ASHES ON ASH WEDNESDAY, FEB. 17

On January 12, Archbishop Leonard Blair, Chair of the Bishops' Committee on Divine Worship, issued a memorandum to all the Bishops of the United States. In it he wrote, "While Ash Wednesday is not a holy day of obligation and while there is no requirement for the clergy and faithful to receive the imposition of ashes, it is rightly observed as a celebration of high importance, and many will surely wish to participate even amid the current difficulties."

Archbishop Blair then shared a message from the Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments. He writes, "During this time of pandemic, the Holy See has modified the method of distributing the ashes, as outlined in the following "Note":

Prot. N. 17/21

NOTE ON ASH WEDNESDAY **Distributions of Ashes in Time of Pandemic**

The Priest says the prayer for blessing the ashes. He sprinkles the ashes with holy water, without saying anything. Then he addresses all those present and only once says the formula as it appears in the Roman Missal, applying it to all in general: "Repent, and believe in the Gospel", or "Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return".

The Priest then cleanses his hands, puts on a face mask and distributes the ashes to those who come to him or, if appropriate, he goes to those who are standing in their places. The Priest takes the ashes and sprinkles them on the head of each one without saying anything.

Archbishop Blair notes that "these changes minimize the necessity of physical contact between minister and recipient and remove the need for the minister to speak while in close proximity to the recipient.

The distribution of ashes via sprinkling is a common practice in some countries but is not well known here. Therefore, the Committee encouraged ministers to provide some explanation to the faithful, to avoid unnecessary confusion.

Walk to Jerusalem Program



In 2020, we began a new program for Lent: "Walk to Jerusalem." Members of St. Alphonsus Parish completed the walk within the first three weeks of Lent. Because of the successs of the program last year, we will once again begin the journey in 2021 on Ash Wednesday with scripture, meditations, and challenges in the bulletin, along with the information on how to report your mileage each week. In addition, we will be offering a list of cathedrals you can visit virtually and learn their historical backgrounds while on our journey. See our weekly bulletin or the church website each week for more information.

Parishioners are invited to participate in the WALK TO JERUSALEM program, which was developed by St. John Providence Health System and designed to increase the physical, spiritual, and emotional health of participants. **The goal is to walk enough miles through the Lenten season to reach Jerusalem by Easter. Our path from St. Alphonsus to Jerusalem is a total of 6,885 miles.**

Each week participants will be able to submit their mileage in one of two ways:

1. Submit your name and mileage via the link on the church website by Friday at 10 AM (1st week ending on February 26): www.alphonsus.org/lent

2. Call the Church Office and let us know your name and mileage by Friday at 10 AM each week. We will collect and update the mileage in the church announcements each week.

As you begin each week, you are invited to focus on the weekly scripture, meditation/reflection, and health message, which will be provided in the bulletin, on the church website, and on the church Facebook page. We invite you to read the scripture passage before starting your physical activity for the week, and as you complete your mileage throughout the week, meditate on the reflection. The health message will give you nutrition and wellness advice, which will relate back to the scripture reading and reflection for the week.

If your fitness calling does not include walking or running, no need to worry. Any fitness or cardio activity (such as swimming or biking, to name a few) lasting 20 minutes will count as 1 mile on this journey to Jerusalem.

So please come on this spiritual journey with us as we become more physically active while also deepening our relationship with God!

**Please note that there is no formal sign-up or registration required. Anyone can join in each week and submit their mileage.*
