Be a Life Saver

Did you know that 93% of us will need blood once in our lifetime for any number of reasons? Did you know that by being a member of this parish, you are covered for blood that you receive? Did you know that the time it takes to donate blood is less than the average lunch time?

If the above is not enough to make you want to donate blood at our next blood drive on May 6, 2018, then keep reading.

10 Reasons to Donate Blood

- Blood transfusions save lives.
- There's no substitute for human blood.
- Every three seconds, someone needs a blood transfusion.
- About 60 percent of the population is eligible to donate blood, yet less than five percent do.
- A pint of blood, separated in to components, can help up to three people.
- You'll make your community a safer place.
- Fulfills your desire to "give back" to the parish and the community.
- You'll receive a mini physical (blood pressure, temperature, iron level).
- You'll learn your blood type.
- It's safe, simple and it saves lives.

You are eligible to give blood if you are over 17 years old, weigh at least 110 pounds, are in good general health, have valid identification, and believe that God wants us to help others. Many people think that certain medical conditions or medicines will keep them from donating. Sometimes, this is true, but call the parish nurse and find out for sure.

What about how it will hurt or I'll "pass out?" You will feel an initial pinch, but it passes quickly. Eating a good meal and drinking fluids prior to donating will minimize the possibility of "passing out." Having a positive attitude helps- think about the lives you will help.

I'm anemic, so I can't give. Anemia is often a temporary condition. Come have a sample of your blood checked before donation.

I don't have enough blood to spare. Everyone who is 17 years old and weighs at least 110 pounds has 10-12 pints of blood in their body. Less than one pint will be removed. This amount can easily be given without adverse effects. Your body's fluid volume will be replaced within 24 hours.
