Service is a call from God, and I thank each of them for responding to this call. The poet and writer Emerson said “ It is one of the beautiful compensations of this life that no one can sincerely try to help others without helping himself. When we do for others we truly feel that great sense of joy in doing.” While there is a good feeling about serving others, studies tell us that serving others is psychologically good for us. A study in Tecumseh Michigan indicated that volunteer work dramatically increased life expectancy. Men who did not volunteer were two and a half times more likely to die earlier than men who volunteered a least once a week. The study went on to say that doing good for others enhanced the immune system. A Harvard study done later went on to say that even thinking about doing service for others produced positive psychological results. In life we are all dependent on each other. We are not just dependent on each other we are interdependent on each other for most of the things we take for granted. Each of us has a part to play and we become more joyful when we do it for others. The words of Saint Francis are always an invitation to serve each other when he says” Lord make me an instrument of Your peace, where there is hatred let me sow love. Where there is injury pardon, where there is doubt faith, where there is despair hope, where there is darkness light, and where there is sadness, joy. Serving God and each other is a gift we all have. May God bless all who serve at Saint Alphonsus in so many ways.

**“Transubstantiation”**

When asked to design the stained glass window for the Adoration Chapel at St. Alphonsus Catholic Church, I envisioned that mystical moment when bread is turned into the body of Christ—Transubstantiation. This large window, nearly 6 feet by 9.5 feet, required additional mullions, or divisions, in order to support a stained glass window of this size. This provided an opportunity to incorporate into the design a circle in the upper region of the window, reinforcing the symbol; of the Holy Eucharist. The palette is primarily warm, in shades of brown, yellow, purple, green and gray to symbolize the varying stages of growing wheat. The white, flickering throughout the window, indicates the presence of the Holy Spirit. As the Eucharist forms in the center of the circular mullions, the lines surrounding it echo the shape. In the bottom of the window, the swirling line work represents the life that God breathes into the Mystical Body.
