Visit the Sick

Because of federal medical privacy laws, hospitals and extended care facilities can no longer alert our parish when a parishioner is admitted to their facility. Part of our ministry is to visit the sick in our hospitals, but we cannot do it without your help. The solution is simple: Tell us when either you or a family member is admitted to a hospital and a visit is appropriate, even if you think others have notified us. As soon as possible, we will arrange for a visit by a priest for prayer and/or anointing of the sick, or a visit by a Deacon for prayer and/or Holy Communion. Registration for the 2019-2020 year began June 1, 2019. Look for registration forms on our website, in the back of the church and in the Faith Formation Office.

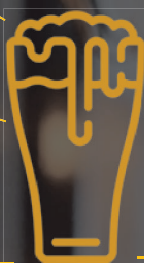
Completed forms are due by June 30, 2019 to receive the early bird discount.
