Father Mike is one of the hardest-working people I know. I've known him to get up at 4:00 AM to go to the office and start working. He never stops and is always available for any project he has been requested to assist on. On his vacations, he enjoys working on his old homestead in Ireland. He seems the happiest working in the church, on countless projects, on the fair, or on a twenty-mile bike trip to relax.

He is a quiet man with a calm demeanor and even keel. He doesn't get rattled if there is a mishap. He just rolls with the punches. Not that long ago while washing his chalice I dropped and chipped it. I was devastated. Father Mike calmly looked at me and said, "things happen." Father is also a private person and asks that other people's privacy be respected.

During meetings, he doesn't ride roughshod over the group. He allows individuals to participate and provide input, while on occasion gently pointing them in the right direction.
