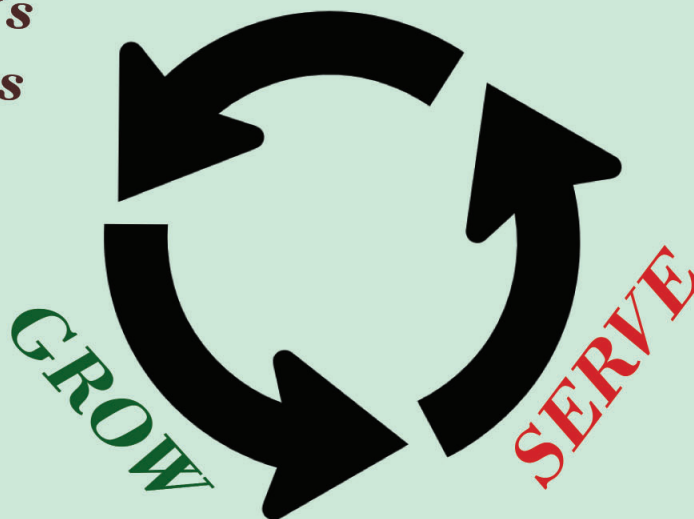

Visit the Sick

Because of federal medical privacy laws, hospitals and extended care facilities can no longer alert our parish when a parishioner is admitted to their facility. Part of our ministry is to visit the sick in our hospitals, but we cannot do it without your help. The solution is simple: Tell us when either you or a family member is admitted to a hospital and a visit is appropriate, even if you think others have notified us. As soon as possible, we will arrange for a visit by a priest for prayer and/or anointing of the sick, or a visit by a Deacon for prayer and/or Holy Communion. 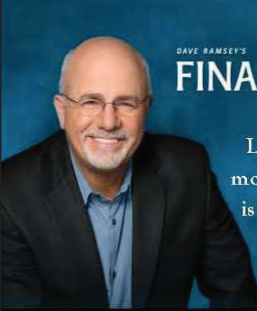

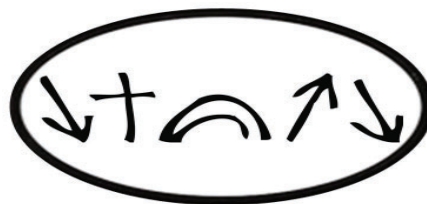
Preschool Jesus and Me (J.A.M.)
