As we approach the 25th anniversary of our Adoration Chapel in December, a few of our adorers would like to share their experiences with you.

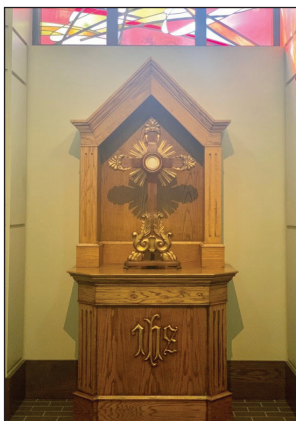
