




# Featured Saint of the Week St. Felix of Nicosia (1715-1787) Feast: June 2

He was born Filippo Giacomo Amoroso, about three weeks after his father had died. As a youngster he apprenticed with a local shoemaker. When not working, he visited the nearby Capuchin friary, and became familiar with both the friars and their way of life.

By age 20, he knew that he wanted to enter the Capuchin Order and requested permission to join. However, because he was illiterate he could not be admitted as a cleric. He continued to renew his requests periodically, and it was only after eight years that his perseverance paid off. He was admitted to the Order, and was sent to Mistretta for his initial training.

Upon entering his novitiate in 1743, he was given the name Brother Felix; professing his vows about a year later. Brother Felix was assigned to the friary in his home town of Nicosia, to work as a quaestor. His job was to travel the region collecting alms in support of the mendicant friars and their work.

Devoted to Christ and the Virgin Mary, on Fridays he contemplated the Passion and death of Jesus Christ. He also had a particularly strong veneration for the Blessed Sacrament, and spent many hours in front of the Tabernacle.

He was endowed with some heaven sent gifts; healing of both physical and spiritual diseases, as well as the ability to bi-locate. He felt it a calling, and readily went to the sick when needed. At one time he traveled to the city of Cerami, to help where a malignant epidemic was decimating the town.

One day while Felix was working in the garden, he was suddenly overcome by a raging fever. The doctor was called, to provide treatment. Felix let the doctor know that medicines would be of no help, because he would not survive this illness. He died later that month on May 31st at the age of 71. Felix was so dedicated to his vow of obedience that he actually requested permission from the Guardian of the community, to die.

Brother Felix was beatified in 1888; his relics were put on display for public veneration in 1891. Pope Benedict XVI canonized St. Felix on October 23, 2005.
