Featured Saint of the Week

St. John Leonardi (1541-1609)

Feast: October 9



John was the youngest of 7 in his family, a quiet child often seeking solitude. At the age of 17, he began studying to become a pharmacist's assistant. After completion, he went on to study for the priesthood. He was ordained in 1572.

He was passionate about Christian formation and began working with adolescents in his parish. He also organized men to work in hospitals and prisons.

Amid the Counter-Reformation movement, Leonardi founded a group charged with deepening Christian faith and devotion. Additionally he worked to spread devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary and of the importance of frequent Communion.

The Council of Trent enacted some dramatic changes for the Church, and specifically the clergy. Welcoming the changes, Leonardi formed a new congregation of secular priests to both convert sinners and to restore Church discipline. His congregation was confirmed by Pope Clement VIII as John of the Mother of God. From a political standpoint another congregation in the area was not welcomed. It resulted in Leonardi going into exile leaving his home in Lucca, for the remainder of his life.

Pope Clement VIII nominated Leonardi for the reform of the local Benedictine monks, as well as for the Vallombrosans.

In 1603 he co-founded the seminary of the Propagation of the Faith in Rome, for philosophical and theological training of missionary priests.

In 1609 while ministering to his priestly brothers from the influenza epidemic, he contracted the disease himself and died.

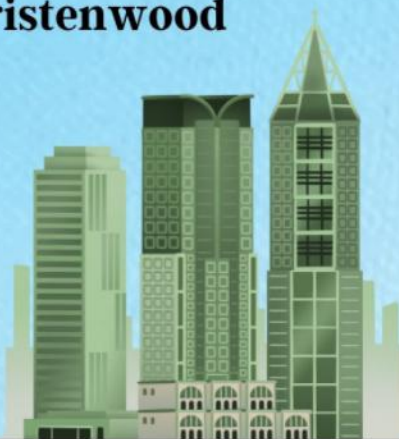
