Featured Saint of the Week St. Maurice (250–287) Feast: September 22

Maurice was born in Thebes, Egypt. He chose a career in the military, and became commander

of the Theban Legion, leading about 1000 men. He, and his troops were all acknowledged Christians; this was at a time when early Christianity was considered a threat to the Roman Empire.

Maurice and his troops were called on by Emperor Maximian in Gaul, to help defend against a potential revolt. They were dispatched to an area across the Alps. But before they went into battle, they were instructed to offer sacrifices to pagan gods and to pay homage to the emperor. Although Maurice pledged his men's military allegiance to Rome, he said service to God supersedes all else. He went on to say that wanton slaughter was inconceivable to Christians. He and his men refused to worship the Roman deities.

The emperor then wanted the army to murder local Christians. Again, Maurice refused. Because of his refusal to sacrifice to pagan gods, plus the refusal to murder Christians, Maximian ordered a systematic decimation of Maurice and his troops; mass martyrdom. This occurred in a place that is now known as Saint-Maurice, Switzerland; it's also the site of the Abbey of St. Maurice.

St. Maurice is well-known and venerated throughout Europe; he's the patron saint of the German Holy Roman Emperors, and has many other various honors as well as a number of churches named in his honor.

For a much closer connection, St. Maurice Church in Arabi, Louisiana, built in 1856, was severely damaged during Katrina in 2005. It was subsequently deconsecrated in 2008, and the property sold.
