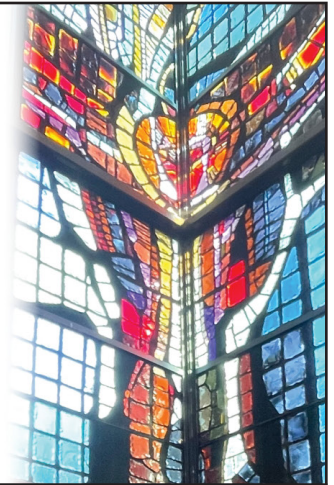

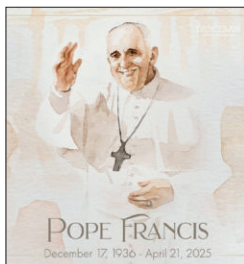

Featured Saint of the Week

St. John Baptist de LaSalle

(4/30/1651-4/7/1719)

Feast: April 7



LaSalle was born into aristocracy in Reims, France. He was tonsured at age 11, in an official ceremony where his parents stated publically of their son's intention to enter into the service of God.

After completing classical, literary, and philosophical courses, he went to Paris to enter the Seminary. He was ordained at the age of 26, in 1678. Two years later he received his doctorate in theology.

His focus soon turned to children who had little hope for social and/or economic advancement. He was determined to use his own talents and advanced education for the service of these children.

His priestly work was primarily focused on the Sacraments, so he decided to resign his canonry to focus his full attention to the establishment of schools and training teachers.

His first step was to train teachers, who were struggling, lacking leadership and purpose. He took them into his own home hoping to inspire and instruct them in their work. These teachers took vows of poverty, chastity, and obedience. LaSalle then started a new religious institute, the first one with no priests among its teaching staff. He called it The Institute of the Brothers of the Christian Schools.

Both the educational establishment and the ecclesiastical authorities complained, but LaSalle moved forward. His dedication resulted in many lasting educational practices.

Doing all of this alone, took its toll on LaSalle. He was worn out by austerity and the exhausting labor, ultimately dying on Good Friday, 1917.

Pope Leo XIII canonized LaSalle on May 24, 1900.
