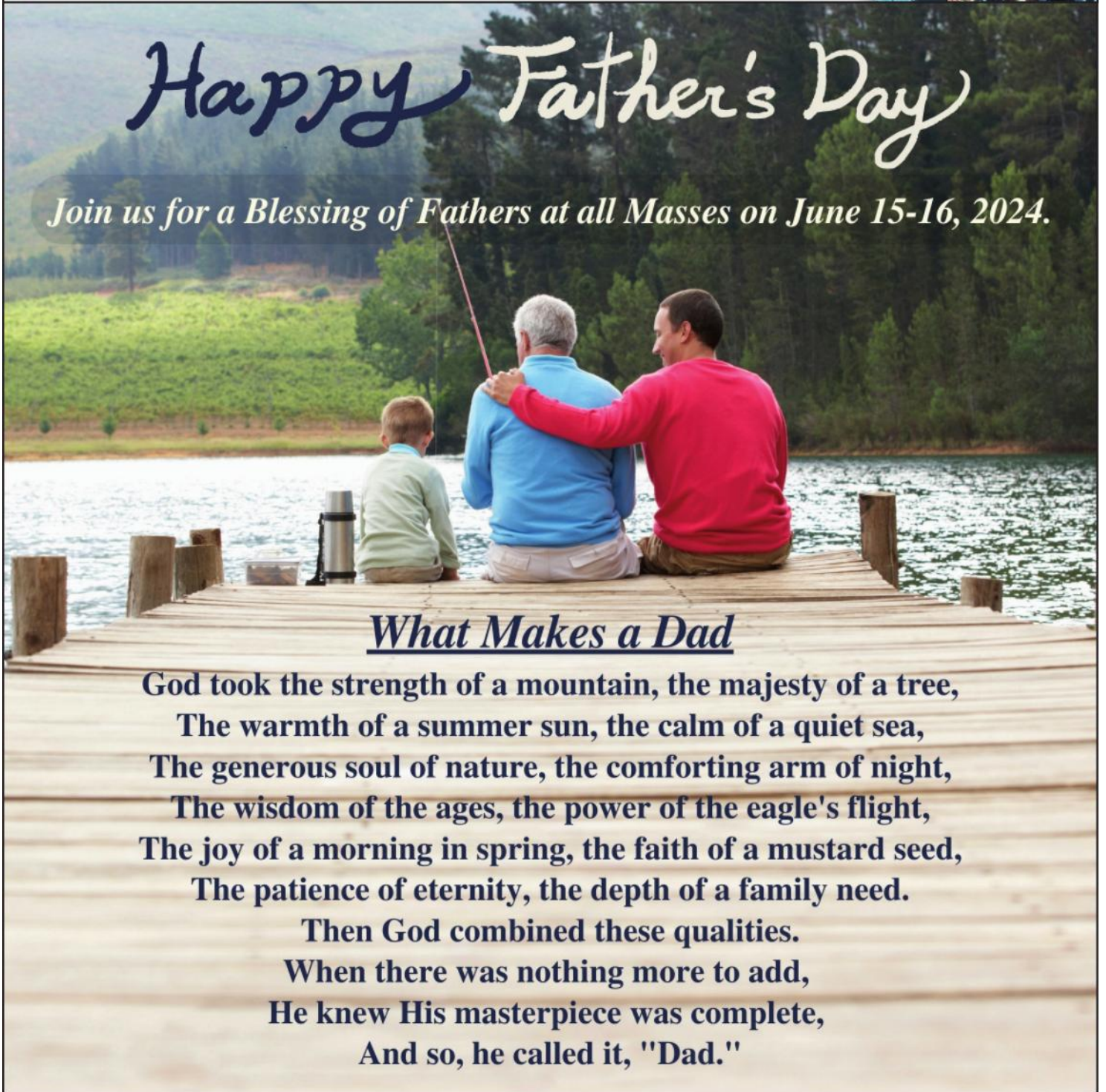

Featured Saint of the Week

St. Conrad of Parzham (1818–1894)
Feast Day: April 21

Conrad was born in Bavaria, Germany, the ninth son of a poor farming family. From a young age, he had a deep prayer life, preferring to spend solitary time with God; he also had a great devotion to Mary and prayed the rosary daily.



At age 31 when his father died, Conrad decided to follow his heart and become a Capuchin Franciscan. He was admitted to the novitiate as a lay brother and was assigned to the friary of St. Ann in Altötting, which served as the National Shrine of Bavaria to the Blessed Mother.

He was assigned to the position of porter/doorman. The position was a challenging one, but with diligence, Conrad became known for being bountiful to the poor, and ready and eager to receive and help strangers. In the 41 years Conrad held the position, he assisted the townspeople in their needs, both in body and soul.

Each spare moment he had, Conrad would visit the Blessed Sacrament in the Chapel, and pray to develop a deepened relationship with the Mother of God. Conrad said his greatest secrets to sanctity were: silence, the Blessed Sacrament, and Mary, Queen of the Friars Minor.

Brother Conrad was able to read the hearts of those he met and had the gift of prophecy. It was because of his heroic virtues and the miracles he performed that Pope Pius XI deemed him as blessed in 1930. After approving additional miracles attributable to Conrad, Pope Pius XI had Conrad's name inserted into the list of Saints in 1934.

Conrad was also known as the Apostle of Charity and a miracle worker with a charism of prophecy. He was the first German named a saint after three centuries of Protestantism.

St. Alphonsus Liguori Catholic Church is a vibrant, faith filled church community located in the heart of Greenwell Springs, LA. With over 3,000 parishioners, we are the largest church in the Central area and boast a deep history and tradition dating back to 1889.

St. Alphonsus Liguori Catholic Church is seeking to hire a **Principal Organist**. The role of the organist is essential to enhancing the Liturgy and overall worship. The Organist will work alongside with the Choir Director to coordinate all music for liturgies, prayer services, parish missions, rehearsals and other areas as needed. This position is available on or around July 1, 2024.

Necessary Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities:

- Must be a skilled organist and pianist, able to play both instruments interchangeably.
- Must be knowledgeable of the Catholic liturgy.
- Must be able to get along well with and lead people to achieve desired goals.
- Must be attentive to details and accuracy.
- Must demonstrate initiative and be self-motivating.
- Must be flexible in meeting the needs of the job and able to follow direction.

Major Responsibilities/Duties:

- Works with the Choir Director in coordinating and planning all liturgies.
- The principal parish organist will play for all parish liturgies, including weekend Masses (Saturday 4:00 PM, Sunday 8:00 AM, 10:00 AM, 12:00 PM), Holy Days of Obligation, Christmas and Easter Masses, prayer services and Way of the Cross services during Lent.
- Attends and accompanies the Weekly Chancel Choir Rehearsal on Wednesdays at 7:00 PM during Choir Season (usually the Wednesday after Labor Day until Pentecost Sunday)
- Responsible for securing a replacement organist for weekend liturgies when the principal organist is unable to play.
- Has the first right of refusal for accompanying on the organ/piano all parish funerals and weddings. Weddings will be paid with an additional stipend, separate of the pay for all other activities.
- Attends the monthly Liturgy Committee Meetings.
- Maintains proper copyright expectations.
- Meets with and assists engaged couples in planning wedding liturgies.
- Oversees the proper maintenance of the organ, piano, and any other parish instruments.
