#### Featured Saint of the Week

#### St. John of Egypt (305-394) Feast: March 27

John of Egypt was born in Lycopolis, Egypt of poor parents. He initially trained as a carpenter; at age 25, under the guidance of an elderly hermit John became a monk, living a life of solitude.



When the old hermit died, John spent the next five years traveling, visiting monasteries. He eventually withdrew to the top of a cliff near his hometown of Lycopolis, where he could avoid all human contact.


There, he carved three small rooms out of rock; one for sleeping, one for working, and the third for praying. He secured the place around himself, leaving open only a small window where people could bring him food and water. For two days of the week (Saturday and Sunday), he would preach from that window. When asked, he would also provide advice to men.

It was believed that he possessed the spiritual gift of prophecy, often predicting the future and knowing details of persons he'd never met. He also predicted future victories of the Emperor Theodosius the Great.

John avoided all people for the last fifty years of his life; yet he was still tempted by demons. He also performed miraculous cures. The last three days of his life were spent without food, drink or any interactions but prayer. He was discovered in his room in a position of prayer.




