EUCCHARISTIC BOAT PROCESSION

August 14-15, 2024

Fete-Dieu du Mississippi

The 10th Annual Eucharistic Boat Procession, born on the bayou, this year will jump ship to the river! The solemn flotilla will embark on the Mighty Mississippi for a one-time only Blessing of the River and the great state of Louisiana!

The extraordinary procession will begin on Wednesday, August 14 at 8 AM at a Votive Mass of the Holy Eucharist by Bishop Duca at St. Joseph Cathedral in Baton Rouge. Following the Mass, there will be a procession with the Blessed Sacrament to the Mississippi River, where the 130-mile procession and blessing will commence. The flotilla should arrive in Convent, LA, at about 5:40 PM, where there will be a procession to the historic St. Michael Church for all-night Adoration.

On August 15, they will process back to the river dock and depart for New Orleans. The flotilla will arrive at about 4:25 PM in the French Quarter, and there will be a great Benediction on the levee at 5:15 PM in front of Jackson Square, followed by a procession into St. Louis Cathedral for a final blessing and a Solemn Mass of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary by Archbishop Gregory Aymond, D.D.

Featured Saint of the Week

Pope St. John XXIII (1881–1963)

Feast Day: October 11



This forward thinking Pope was planning to make a life changing impact on every practicing Roman Catholic in the world.

Pope John XXIII felt that the Church needed to be brought up-to-date. His solution was to convene the Second Ecumenical Council, better known as Vatican II. He wanted to modernize the Church, fostering unity while making it more relevant to a secularized world.

Much of the impact of Vatican II was the result of these four constitutions:

Lumen Gentium (Light of the World): Updating the liturgy and bringing the light of Christ to the world.

Dei Verbum (Word of God): Highlighting Divine Revelation-How God willed us into being and chose to reveal God's self to us.

Sancrosanctum Concilium (Sacred Council): Changing so that we can celebrate the liturgy with the priest and in the local vernacular; increased roles for lay people, while we focus on the importance of community prayer.

Gaudium et Spes' (Joy and Hope): Calls for the Church to engage in dialogue with contemporary society and its problems; it further calls for the Church to bring its teachings and moral values to the world.

By late 1962 Pope John XXIII had executed most of the work for which he would be known. But he was diagnosed with stomach cancer, which at that time was a terminal diagnosis. On June 3, 1963, he died at age 81.

When he died, Vatican II took a break in honor of Pope John XXIII. It resumed, and completed its work under Pope Paul VI on December 8, 1965.

Pope John Paul XXIII was canonized at the same time as Pope John Paul II in 2014.
