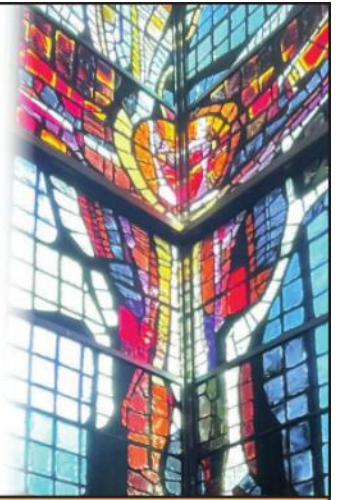

Dear Parishioners of St. Alphonsus:

I would like to take the opportunity to thank everyone for the very warm welcome over the last two weeks. Last Sunday, I had five offers for dinner, and I had to kindly rain check four of them.

I also want to compliment Blaine Baker, Colby Novo, and all of the young adult mentors who put on a fabulous lock-in last weekend in the Parish Activity Center. I was able to pop in a few times during the lock-in and spoke to the 38 youth in attendance about my desire to get a parish bus and to bring them on a trip next summer.

Speaking of trips, I was told by Father Mike that St. Alphonsus parishioners like to travel. I started marketing a trip to France in February, and I would love to have some folks consider joining my group in October. I normally like to take a group on pilgrimage in the fall each year, and as part of our listening sessions, I would be curious to see where you would like to go in the future. I have not planned a fall 2025 pilgrimage yet, but I am open to going just about anywhere except Italy next year. They are predicting 20 to 30 million more travelers in 2025 because it is a jubilee year.

As we look ahead, a new school year is upon us, and I am excited to work with our new principal, Ms. Kristy Monsour, to look at future expansion plans for the school, as our enrollment will only grow in years ahead. I am also focusing on the Catholic Daughters National Convention, which will be held in New Orleans from August 13-18. As the Louisiana state chaplain, I am in charge of preparing all of the liturgies for the convention. If you would like to help me move some items that we need for the convention to New Orleans, and help with the pick up, please let me know.

Featured Saint of the Week

St. Katharine Drexel (1858–1955)
Feast Day: March 3



St. Katharine was one of two children born to a wealthy banker and his wife; Mrs. Drexel unfortunately died just five weeks after Katharine was born. Katharine received a wonderful education, had a rich spiritual life, and lived comfortably. She and her family were engaged in living out both the spiritual and corporal works of mercy. Katharine became imbued with a passionate love for God and neighbor.

While on a family trip, she saw first-hand the terribly poor and troubling situations of both Native Americans and Black Americans. She realized early in life that no amount of money could shelter people from pain and suffering. She desperately wanted to help make a difference, primarily but not exclusively for both Native Americans and Black Americans. Her intention was to pass on her love of the Eucharist and to continue working toward unifying peoples.

She met with Pope Leo XIII in order to get approval to found the Sisters of the Blessed Sacrament. She also spoke with him about the need for missionaries to work with the poor. He challenged her to get the ball rolling herself, by doing missionary work. She began doing just that and was quite successful.

Archbishop James Blenk asked “Mother” Katharine to come to New Orleans to open the way for the education of the black youth of the city. Katharine agreed. With the help of the Sisters of the Blessed Sacrament, they began by establishing Xavier High School, later known as Xavier Preparatory School. They then began to start work on Xavier University of Louisiana. It is the only historically black Catholic university in Louisiana. Ultimately she was responsible for 60 missions and schools around the country.

In the late 1930s, Mother Katharine suffered a major heart attack. By 1937 her health limited her activities exclusively to the Motherhouse. On March 3, 1955 at the age of 96, she succumbed. She was canonized on October 1, 2000, by Pope John Paul II.
