
The Seventeenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Featured Saint of the Week

St. Charles Borromeo (1538-1584)

Feast Day: November 4

Charles Borromeo was born into wealth. He decided early on to dedicate his life to the service of the church, keeping money only for his education and donating any other funds to the Church for the poor.



In 1559 his uncle, Pope Pius IV asked Fr. Borromeo to become his full-time advisor in Rome. He was so successful in his work, that within months he was promoted to Cardinal. Charles was smart and wore quite a number of hats in his position. In addition to his assigned duties, he played a leading role in the Counter-Reformation, along with friends and future saints Ignatius of Loyola and Philip Neri. Charles was responsible for the founding of several hospitals and schools, as well as seminaries for the education of priests.

His name is notably associated with reform. He lived during the Protestant Reformation and was a major player in the reform of the entire Catholic Church.

Cardinal Borromeo was a driving force in the final years of the Council of Trent (1545-1563), defining Catholic doctrine and making a number of decrees for the Church's self-reform. At the time, his work was a tremendous factor revitalizing the Roman Catholic Church in the face of Protestant expansion. The declarations and anathemas from the Council of Trent have since been confirmed, by both Vatican II and the official "Catechism of the Catholic Church."

After the Council in 1564, Borromeo was designated as the Archbishop of Milan, a position he maintained until his death in 1584.

"If a tiny spark of God's love already burns within you, do not expose it to the wind, for it may get blown out. Keep the stove tightly shut so that it will not lose its heat and grow cold. In other words, avoid distractions as well as you can." -St. Charles Borromeo




