

Featured Saint of the Week St. Mary MacKillop (1842–1909) Feast Day: August 8

Australia's Mary MacKillop was dedicated to the education of poor and marginalized kids as well as teaching them life skills for a more productive life. In March 1866, Mary opened a school that set



the pattern for future schools to continue teaching as she was doing. Mary also opened places of refuge for the rehabilitation of people in need.

Mary's work grew, attracting other women to join with her mission. Having so many come in to help, Mary developed a Rule for the Sisters of St. Joseph of the Sacred Heart, as they came to be known. Their mission was to meet the both the material and spiritual needs of struggling people. She chose the spiritual name: "Mary of the Cross.

Mary had what was considered a radical vision for the Order's structure. She did not want the Order to be subject to the Bishops of the diocese, but to be self-governing with a Mother Superior. She wanted each sister to help with the work regardless of her background. Mary's plan put her in direct conflict with the Bishop of Adelaide, which resulted in her excommunication on September 22, 1871.

She would not be deterred. Mary took her cause to Pope Pius IX in Rome. The excommunication order was reversed on February 23, 1872. Within one year she received Vatican approval for the Order. During this period Mary's attitude was one of forgiveness and respect. As Mother Superior for the Order, she routinely showed vision, courage, and leadership skills.

In May 1901, Sr. Mary of the Cross had a stroke. Although her r-side was paralyzed, her mind and speech remained intact. Sr. Mary succumbed to the illness on August 8, 1909.

On October 17, 2010, she was canonized as the first saint from Australia.
